

- SOLOS AGE is as at 1St JAN 2020, all dancers must dance in their correct age section
- TROUPES Average age as at 1st JAN 2020
- All dancers / competitors compete at their own risk. Shine Bright Dance Challenge takes <u>NO</u> responsibility for any accidents, injury, or death to any persons associated with the eisteddfod, either as a competitor, volunteer, or a member of the public, at any time.
- The adjudicators decision is final... any teachers, parents and or competitors approaching the adjudicator will be disqualified and asked to leave the venue
- All competitors / parents give their permission for photos to be used by Shine Bright Dance Challenge for promotional material, this includes results etc. on social media
- **NO** videoing or photography is allowed from the audience. If caught doing so you will be asked to leave the venue. □

- NO REFUNDS (only transfers if approved and will be of a fee of \$30)
- Due to child protection laws please use the change rooms provided, <u>NO</u> changing in the main hall.
- NO practising in the hall
- Event is an Alcohol FREE zone
- Tap shoes are to be covered
- Nobody to be back stage except competitors and carers of babies under
 5's and also under 6's, unless helping with props
- No resin to be used
- All programs will be emailed unless other arrangements have been made
- Music CD's are to be labelled with your child's name and marked if they start on or off the stage Spare copies of CD's is a great idea
- Comp Open for Dancers who dance less than 15 hours per week
- Impros will be danced in age sections only
- Plain Leo or crop and shorts are to be worn for Impros
- Sections may be combined if needed due to lack of entries but adjudicated according to the level and or age
- Music is to be relevant to the age of the performer
- Copy of child's birth certificate required on entry
- Prompting will not be permitted except for in the babies sections
- All competitors must perform in order of programme
- There is to be quiet in the hall at all times
- No dancer is to perform out of section
- Unfinished dances may be repeated at the discretion of the adjudicator except 10yrs and over.
- Shine Bright Dance Challenge reserves the right to change competition days or move location due to unforeseen circumstances
- Song and Dance routines <u>NO</u> vocals allowed during singing sections
- Time Limits: Babies (U5) 2.5mins Solos 3mis

SOLO SECTION DEFINITIONS:

- <u>Specially Restricted</u> For competitors who have never won that style of dance at any competitions
- <u>Restricted</u> For competitors who have not won restricted in that style but have won in the specially restricted for that style (Babies sections are not taken into count)
- Open for competitors who have won specially restricted and restricted for that style. Or for competitors who dance more than 13hours per week

Temperatures will be taken on entry – temps over 37.5 will be re taken 10mins later if still over 37.5 they will not be able to enter

Hand sanitiser stations will be throughout the hall please use them

Gloves and Masks are available if needed or wanted

Seats will be put out but we ask that every second seat with a cross on it not be used (this is keeping with social distancing)unless you are members of the same household

No standing within the venue – all attendees must be seated to comply with regulations

All seats will be wiped down with viraclean before the event and also again in each session break aswell as back stage, door hands etc.

We ask that between each session you leave the hall so that a clean can be done and then return if needed once the next session is due to start

There will be 30-45min session breaks to accommodate the above

Please arrive 20mins before session start time and arrive ready for first dance in that session. On entry you will be asked to fill in a form re: Covid 19 details

Crosses will be marked on the floor back stage and side stage and we ask dancers do not move to the next cross while waiting until told too

Crosses will also be marked at the entry, canteen, music table that we ask you abide by

Please abide by all signs

For the safety of others If Rules are not abided by we will have to ask you to leave the hall

We can only have a certain amount of people in the change room / toilet at one time so there may be a wait please be patient... extra change tents will be put up to help with this

Please try to keep 1.5mtrs away from dancers, staff and spectators at all times

Maintain good hand hygiene

If you are unwell we ask that you do not attend the event

In keeping with social distancing and restrictions this comp we have decided not to run Impros or Championships
