Southern Federation of Dance is once again offering the opportunity to undertake First Aid training at an organised workshop. The following course is being offered in 2021:

Full First Aid Course (HLTAID003 Provide First Aid) to comply with approved code of practice for first aid in the work place, which includes CPR, First Aid Essential Skills & Knowledge, PLUS Basic Anaphylaxis and Asthma. There will also be specific focus on first aid for dance related injuries. **Candidates will need to complete 3-6 hours of pre-course online theory for this workshop.**

Cost: \$110 p/person

A qualified and experienced Trainer will provide all the training equipment, including CPR manikins, laptop, projector etc. Training content is per current guidelines of the ARC (Australian Resuscitation Council). Strict Covid-19 preventative measures will be in place.
