Rules & Conditions:

- Competitors compete strictly at their own risk, no responsibility will be taken for any accident, injury or loss of property, this includes all people present as well as competitors.
- Only amateurs may enter the eisteddfod, anyone earning a full-time wage from either teaching or performing cannot enter.
- Proof of age must be available immediately. You must have proof of age with you throughout
 the eisteddfod. If competitor's ages are questioned and you cannot prove their age, you will
 be disqualified.
- No one is permitted to approach the adjudicator at any time. The decision of the adjudicator is final.
- Prompting is permitted in 4/u & 6/u sections only. There is to be no prompting in any other sections. Anyone caught prompting with be disqualified immediately.
- Time limits (including tags) All Solo's 3 minutes. Anyone not adhering to these time limits will be disqualified
- Once the program has been emailed, music must be uploaded to musicuploads.com.au
- No competitor will dance out of order of the program unless permission is granted by the committee.
- Any section can be cancelled or joined at the discretion of the committee.
- If you have not received your program one week before the eisteddfod it is solely your responsibility to send an email to advise of this so another can be emailed.

- All competitors / teachers are responsible for ensuring they have appropriate insurance and licensing with APRA/AMCOS.
- 2 teachers per studio will be granted free admission if they supply their WWCC number.
- A professional videographer will be available. No personal videography or photography is permitted.
- No photography is permitted in the auditorium or in change rooms.
- All Town Hall Theatre rules must be abided by. The stage is approximately 7 metres wide and 5.5 metres deep.
- No food or drinks are permitted in the theatre.
- Awards will be given out at the end of each age group.
- See rules below for sections and age champions.
- Any rule may be amended at the discretion of the committee.
- The committee will make the final decision on anything not covered in these rules.

4/u Dance (maximum of 2 routines)

6/u – Jazz, Tap, Lyrical/Contemporary, Classical

8/u 10/u 12/u 14/u 15/o - Jazz, Broadway Jazz, Fast Tap, Slow Tap, Lyrical, Contemporary, Classical, Hip Hop

**You may only enter each section once.

AGE CHAMPIONS

- Age Champions:
 - o Mini Age Champion 6 years and under
 - Junior Age Champion 8 years and under
 - o Intermediate Age Champion 9 12 years
 - o Senior Age Champion 13 years and over
- Age champions are open to all competitors
- You must compete in at least one solo section to enter age champions
- You can repeat routines or perform a new routine
- 2 entries permitted per person
- All competitors will receive a place
- Music must be sent when you receive program

DUO'S - Duo's sections must have 2 dancers.

Combined styles of dance for each age group - 6/u, 8/u, 10/u, 12/u, 14/u & 15/o

**You may only enter each section twice only, with different styles of dance for each routine.
