Welcome to EEE @ Pennant Hills Community Centre

Venue – Community Centre

The Pennant Hills Community Centre is a large venue that can hold up to 300 ppl. The community centre has a stage size of 9.5m x 12.5m & is wooden. EEE will provide resin for dancers. This venue DOES NOT have tarket. All dancers MUST come dressed with hair & make up done. There is a small change room for the dancers on the side of the stage for solos & during the troupe session on Saturday evening the small & medium halls have been booked for changerooms. Spectators are able to sit anywhere in the hall & MUST remain seated throughout. Masks are optional & personal choice. The canteen is located at the rear of the hall.

Championships

Those entered in Championships, will only perform their new non repeat dance in the Championship sections & all other routines that Championship dancers are entered in at EEE will be included in results. Adjudicators are aware of the dancers who have entered Championships at EEE as it is noted on their spreadsheet.

Improvisations

Improvisation dancers will receive their Improvisation song in a group email prior to competition day. Please listen to the song choice prior to competition day & be prepared as dancers will NOT re-listen to the song on the day. Improvisation is 1min ONLY and will be any part of the song. Improvisation dancers can wear anything to compete as there is no marks for costume.

Competition

A competition is a situation in which two or more people or groups are trying to get something which not everyone can have. A competition is more than just one person, its 2 or more. A competition is an activity or condition of striving to gain or win something by defeating or establishing superiority over others. Please understand that EEE is running a competition, hence why there are combined variety sections in the program. This is to ensure that dancers are competing against another person in a competition environment.

Presentations

Junior Presentations will take place on stage however, for all other age groups, Miss Rachael will constantly announce results throughout the event & performers can collect their reports/medals/ribbons once results have been announced. Photo opportunities on stage will be possible. If time permits, Troupes will be presented onstage.

EEE Sydney Titles

Those dancers who reach a top score of over 90% will be invited to EEE Sydney Titles to re-compete for EEE Overall Title Championships in their preferred style. This event will take place in Feb 2024. An email will be sent to those performers who qualify for EEE Sydney Titles.

COVID-19
