Rules & Conditions — BY ENTERING, YOU HAVE AGREED TO ABIDE BY ALL RULES

- 1. Age taken 1/1/2024.
- 2. All competitors perform at their own risk. EEE will accept NO RESPONSIBILITY for injury, accident or loss of property that occurs during the Eisteddfod & applies to all attending.
- 3. The adjudicators decision is FINAL. No one is permitted to approach the Adjudicator during the competition or during breaks.
- 4. All mobile phones must be switched to silent when within the auditorium.
- 5. All music MUST be emailed by midday of the due date before the competition starts. Any music not received by this time will incur a 0.5 deduction per routine. It is suggested to bring a spare copy of music on competition day on usb.
- 6. Distraction from the side of the stage will not be tolerated while a competitor is performing & could lead to disqualification. Prompting allowed for Babies & U/6.
- 7. Time Limits:- 2.5 3mins = solo/duo/trio/quad 4mins = Troupes
- 8. Entries may close earlier if the event is full
- 9. The minimum number of entries for each section will be four (4), except as EEE may decide.
- 10. EEE reserves the right to amend the program where necessary, appoint a substitute adjudicator, divide or join any section, or alter days, location or times, etc throughout the eisteddfod.
- 11. ARRIVAL TIME: AT LEAST 45 MINUTES BEFORE ANTICIPATED TIME OF SECTION COMMENCEMENT. Please adhere to this rule to avoid unnecessary time wastage.
- 12. Official video contractor available. NO PRIVATE VIDEOS, DIGITAL CAMERAS OR PHONE CAMERAS ALLOWED.
- 13. Vocal and Song & Dance entries are not permitted to use any pre-recorded vocals on their submitted music. Vocal solo has a microphone option at EEE.

 14. Large sections in any category will be split in half & judged separately as two sections. (There will be a maximum of 15 items per section.)
- 15. REFUNDS will not be made on any entry fee paid once received by EEE. Those that choose to transfer their entry to another EEE will incur a \$15 admin fee. Transfer only applies prior to program being emailed. Dancers can not transfer for change of mind or clash of dates once the program has been emailed.
- 16. If any EEE event is cancelled due to a pandemic/venue cancellation/events beyond EEE control, a refund or transfer will be offered.
- 17. Injury/severe sickness/covid will need to provide proof in order for a transfer or refund.
- 18. Energy Express Eisteddfod will adhere to any special request for times or days PRIOR to the program being written.
- 19. Troupe Sections must contain a minimum of 5 dancers, with Troupe Age being the average of all competitors. Birth certificates may be asked for if age group is questionable!!! Honesty would be appreciated by all dance schools.
- 20. Any dancer who enters an EEE region after the entries close must pay \$2.50 per routine late fees.21. Rachael Heggarty (event organiser) can be appointed adjudicator on competition day in an

emergency. Rachael does not teach any competition kids/routines at any studio in Sydney. Rachael has over 25 years experience in the dance industry.

Age Groups -

Babies, (Junior) U/6, U/8, (Intermediate) U/10, U/12, (Senior) U/14, U/16 & OPEN Improvisations- Ballet, Tap (any style), Jazz/Hip

Improvisations- Ballet, Tap (any style), Jazz/Hip Hop/Cabaret, Modern, Contemporary. Students can wear anything for impro as there is no costume mark.

Open: - Are for those Rest performers who have previously received 1st place at any Eisteddfod in that style.

Restricted: - Are for those performers who have previously received 1st in SR or are current 2nd & 3rd place getters at any Eisteddfod in that style (excluding HC)

<u>Specially Restricted</u>:- Are for those performers who have NEVER previously received a place at any Eisteddfod in that style.

Once a dancers has moved up a level, they stay in that level whether performing anew routine or not. They also stay in that level when they change age groups.

Jazz/Modern/Contemp Championships — A New routines of any of the following styles — Cabaret, Funk, Hip Hop, Traditional Jazz, Modern or Contemporary. New routine MUST NOT be a repeat To Qualify:— 2 dances required in OPEN sections — Jazz, Contemporary, Modern Lyrical, Acrobatics, Broadway/MT/Cabaret or Hip Hop.

Tap Championships — A New Tap Routines of any Tap style. New routine MUST NOT be a repeat To Qualify — 2 dances required in OPEN sections — Fast, Slow, Waltz, Ensemble.

<u>Ballet Championships</u> – A New Routine of either Classical or Demi Character style. New routine MUST NOT be a repeat

To Qualify – 2 Dances required in OPEN sections – Classical, Demi Character, Contemporary or Modern Lyrical

*Those dancers who reach a top score of over 90% will be invited to <u>EEE Sydney Titles</u> to re-compete for EEE Overall Title Championships in their preferred style. This event will take place in February 2025.
