There are Male & female toilets in the fover. Toilets CAN NOT be used for changing. Seven Hills High School has an under stage dressingroom for dancers to change. There is also a sink, mirrors, stage access. All dancers MUST come dressed with hair & make up done to ensure a quick running event. EEE will also have access to the toilet block across the pval at Seven Hills High School. Its is suggested that studios also bring tents to put up & change in the guad as this is closer to the hall than the toilet block.
