### **Venue –Boronia Showroom**

The Boronia Showroom is located at the rear of Saints Sports Cub St Marys. Please use the Holiday Inn Boronia Rd entrance to the club for access. The stage size is 12m x 7m approx. This venue DOES NOT have tarket. EEE will provide resin for dancers. All dancers MUST come dressed with hair & make up done. EEE has organised a dressingroom area (partitions) & numerous marquee for changing. There are separate bathrooms for dancers near changes rooms. Spectator's bathrooms are located on the opposite side of the auditorium. There is a private Bar in the Boronia Showroom for all EEE families. Food can be purchased & consumed in the auditorium from one of the 5x different restaurants/cafes within the club. No external food to be brought into the club.
