RULES AND CONDITIONS:

1. Please note eligibility rules, see further info in dance rules section.
2. Incomplete or Incorrect Entries may not be accepted. Please verify that all details are correct and notify the Convenors immediately of any required changes. Changes are unable to be made once the final programme has been done. Please double check- correct age group has been entered.
3. All attempts are made to provide accurate information in our dance programmes. If names etc are incorrect please advise the Convenor so this can be changed on any certificates, facebook posts etc.
4. Invoices will be provided via the online system.
5. There will be no refund of fees under any circumstances, except for cancellation due to Government enforced shutdown. If the event is shutdown then a one time \$15.00 fee will be deducted from each performer.
6. This year ALL MUSIC is to be uploaded through Music Uploads.
7. Programmes can be purchased at the venue. Groups: \$7.00 and Solos: \$10.00
8. All competitors are required to pay for a Competitors Pass. A competitor competing in both group and solo events will need one for each event.
9. All persons wishing to enter the auditorium must purchase a ticket for our groups event. Our solo event competitor pass includes free entry for all spectators.
10. The society reserves the right to make significant changes if the event has to be held under Covid conditions.

CODE OF ETHICS:

Performers are expected to afford the same consideration to others as they would expect for themselves, at all times.

To ensure that adequate consideration is given, we ask that you understand and abide by the following rules:

- Give due acclaim and encouragement to each other in the spirit of friendship in which the Eisteddfod movement has been fostered over the years. This expectation is of our competitors and school/studio group teachers & their families.
- Do not attempt to intimidate or distract a performer at any time.
- When entering the auditorium do not walk in front of the Adjudicator. Please take your seats quickly and remain seated at all times while a performance is in progress.
- Maintain silence from the time that a performer appears on stage until the end of the performance and while the Adjudicator is speaking.
- The eisteddfod committee reserve the right to ask a competitor, school/studio or patron to leave the premises in a circumstance of poor conduct.

AUDITORIUM RULES:

Entry / Exit

Doors will be closed during performances - entry to or exit from the auditorium will not be permitted.

Silence

Members of the audience are requested to maintain silence and to remain seated during performances, adjudications and announcements.

Photography / Recording

Under copyright law, and child protection requirements, the use of cameras (including mobile phone cameras) and video recorders is **FORBIDDEN**, unless specifically authorised by The Ipswich Junior Eisteddfod Society Inc., for official/publicity purposes.

Professional videotaping and photography are available through **JVE Productions**. They will be videoing all performances, please see their friendly staff in the foyer to place your orders.

Mobile Phones / Electronic Devices

All mobile phone and electronic devices (including pagers) must be switched off or placed on silent.

GENERAL:

1. These Rules apply to the Music, Dance, and Speech and Drama sections of The Ipswich Junior Eisteddfod Society Inc.
2. Rules and Conditions as printed in the Schedules and Programmes are valid for, and continue to be valid for, the period of the Eisteddfod.
3. Competitors, teachers, parents and guardians will be regarded as being conversant with the rules of the Society. Lack of knowledge will not be accepted as a bona fide reason for the infringement of any rule.
4. Items are open to amateurs only. "Amateurs" are persons who do not earn the major portion of their income from the practice of Music, Dance, or Speech and Drama. Amateurs include individuals who have spot-parts in Theatrical Performance, Concerts, sporadic events and advertising campaigns.
5. Competitors compete at their own risk.
6. The Committee reserves the following rights:
 - to amend the programme as necessary.
 - to refuse any entry.
 - to ask any competitor to provide proof of age.
 - to appoint a substitute adjudicator.
 - to adjudicate on any misinterpretation of these rules.
 - to adjudicate on any issue not covered by these rules.
 - to divide an item if there are excessive entries.
 - to cancel an item if there are insufficient entries.
 - to combine age groups if there are insufficient entries.
 - To make significant changes if the event has to be held under Covid conditions
1. Decisions of the Committee are final and binding on all matters.
2. Protests must be in writing, signed and lodged with the convenor within half an hour of the reason for the protest occurring. Protests must be accompanied by a \$10.00 fee. This amount will be forfeited if the protest is considered invalid or is over-ruled by the Committee. Protests can be made only by competitors, their teachers, parents or guardians.
3. The Adjudicator's decision is final within the bounds of the Rules and Conditions.
4. The Adjudicator has the discretion, following concurrence with the Committee, to withhold a prize.
5. All Awards and Bursaries are awarded at the discretion of the Adjudicator and/or the relevant committees.
6. This year Dance will be using voice critics, these will be available on the Music Uploads platform by the time the event finishes.
7. Competitors, teachers, parents, guardians or other interested parties, shall not discuss competition related matters with the Adjudicator. Communication with the Adjudicator at the Adjudication table is forbidden. All enquiries shall be directed to the Convenor.
8. Competitors must report to the Conductor of Sessions before the start of an item. Permission to compete will not be granted to any competitor who has not reported before the final performance has begun in an item.
9. Competitors must not perform out of the order as printed in the programme, without prior permission of the Convenor.
10. **All PERSONS wishing to ENTER the VENUE MUST PURCHASE AN ENTRY TICKET (Even if only going to Dressing Rooms)**
11. Naked flames or fuelled lamps will not be allowed on stage under any circumstances.
12. Any competitor who uses a prop in an unsafe manner, or who acts in a manner that could result in personal injury or property damage whilst on stage or backstage, will be disqualified.
13. If a 240V extension lead is required, it will be provided by a Convenor. Please notify a Convenor one (1) month prior to the start of the Eisteddfod.
14. Competitors must wear suitable footwear at all times when side stage.
15. Collection and engraving of Cups, Trophies and Shields etc are the responsibility of the winners.
16. Perpetual trophies must be returned to a Convenor one (1) month prior to the start of the following Eisteddfod.
17. Photocopying facilities are not available at the venue.
18. Limited ATM facilities are now available – no Cash withdrawal
19. **PHOTOGRAPHY and USE of IMAGE for the 2026 IJES DANCE EISTEDDFOD.** All persons accept that, by participating in this Eisteddfod, they will be photographed or filmed and that these images may be used by IJES for promotion of the Society. IJES will not pass any image/s onto a third party unless prior approval is sought. Please be aware JVE Productions as the Official Photographic provider, may use images to promote their service at the Eisteddfod. **PLEASE CONTACT A CONVENOR IF PRIVACY IS REQUIRED FOR A COMPETITOR.**
20. Venue Stage Size is Width 10.5 mtrs x Depth 8.5 mtrs.

DANCE:

1. The Society is now required to pay a fee for each piece of music played at the Eisteddfod to AMCOS/ APRA (refer page 7). In 2025 this fee has been added into each performance.
2. Competitors who have had professional contact with the Adjudicator within the past twelve months will not be eligible to enter this Eisteddfod.
3. The Adjudicator reserves the right to terminate any performance. This, however, does not necessarily mean a disqualification or disapproval.
4. Competitors must not rehearse on stage, on the balcony, in the foyer or in the aisles of the venue during the Eisteddfod.
5. Competitors are not allowed to wear uncovered tap shoes in the venue.
6. Competitors must have "taps" attached to their shoes in all items where tapping is performed. Failure to do so will mean disqualification. Back-stage personnel may inspect shoes.
7. Competitors who stop during a performance and leave the stage may reappear for comments only. (Except for 8 years and under and restricted items).
8. Competitors must perform in the relevant age items in Solo, Duo and Trio items.
9. Competitors must perform in their given item as listed in the programme.
10. Item routines are not allowed to be repeated in multiple sections except for designated Championship and High Score Champion Items. Changes of music and/or costumes do not constitute a change in routine.
11. **The Restricted Solo Items are only open to competitors who have never been placed First, Second or Third in the genre being entered at any previous Dance Eisteddfod prior to our entry closing date.**
12. **Restricted Groups are for Dance Studios who have not placed 1st in that genre/item at the Ipswich Junior Eisteddfod within the 5 years prior** (note: results are only recorded if there are 3 or more items in the section). These items are designed for smaller and /less competitive dance schools. The committee would appreciate if entering these items is done so in fairness to other entrants. Please contact a Convenor for any clarification.
13. Competitors in the Jazz – Championship items who are not present at the beginning of the item when called by the Conductor of Sessions will be automatically excluded (due to the improvisation component).
14. Competitors in Championship items must perform in the order as printed in the programme or they will be disqualified.
15. To be eligible to compete in a Championship item, a competitor must have performed in the following relevant items:
 - Tap Championship Tap – Solo/ Waltz/ Speed (Any two only) **Speed may be repeated.**
 - Song & Dance Championship Song and Tap/Song and Dance/Musical Theatre (Any one only) **Musical Theatre may be repeated.**
 - Jazz Championship Lyrical or Contemporary and Jazz – Up Tempo. **Jazz Up tempo may be repeated**
 - Classical Championship Classical – Solo and Character/Demi-Character. **Demi-Character may be repeated.**
16. All Championship items require 2 or more dances to be performed, one may be repeated from age items (**See Above**) The other must be a new dance.
17. High Score rules and information please see pages 12 & 20 of schedule.
18. **Vocal backing is not permitted in the vocal section of Song and Dance items or in the entire track for Musical Theatre Items.**
19. Competitors in Solo items may perform only once in any item, including Restricted Items.
20. Competitors in the Duo or Trio items may perform a maximum of twice, in any item, with a different combination of partners.
21. Participants are not allowed to perform in more than two groups in a Group item. **Participants in Primary or Highschool Groups may perform up to 4 times only.**
22. All Group items must have a minimum of four (4) dancers.
23. All dressing rooms are Unisex. Anyone requiring special consideration **must notify a Convenor prior to entry closing date.** Dancing Studios must use the allocated dressing rooms. Teachers/parents in dressingrooms are to be kept to a minimum and presence purposeful in nature (no loitering).
24. Time limits include entries and exits and are maximum times. Exceeding the time limit will result in deduction of points or may result in the disqualification of that performance.
25. Stage curtains will remain open throughout the Eisteddfod and may only be used for the Primary School Group and Acrobatic items.
26. All performances that leave excessive debris on the stage area will be the responsibility of that teacher/parent to clear prior to the next performance not the Conductor of sessions.
27. The Conductor of sessions may ask teachers, parents or friends to leave side stage if they deem it necessary.
28. Children are not allowed to sit on the floor of the venue in front of the Adjudicator or in the aisles..
29. A sound technician will be provided to play all music throughout the Eisteddfod. In 2025 ALL MUSIC is to be uploaded through Music Uploads.
30. Prompting of competitors by teacher and/or parents is not permitted. (Except for 5 years and under items).
31. All female competitors **must wear tights/stockings** for all performances. (With the exception of Acrobatic and Hip Hop Items only).
32. All competitors in Own Choreography and Improvisation Items are required to wear **Basic Black Dance Attire with No Sparkles or Studio Logos.**

MUSIC LICENSING:

The New APRA, AMCOS, ARIA and PPCA **'Blanket Licensing Rule'** is continuing to increase each year. It covers the use of copyright music and sound recording at all Eisteddfods throughout Australia. In 2025 this fee has been added into each performance.

The fees collected by the Eisteddfod are paid to the licensing authority which will distribute about 85% to the songwriter's, composers and music publishers whose works are being performed. For more information www.apraamcos.com.au

GENRE DESCRIPTIONS:

Solo Tap:

Any style or tempo of tapping, including techniques such as; tonality, musicality, rhythm and syncopation.

- No pre-recorded Tap sounds in the music are allowed.
- Tap shoes must be worn

Waltz Tap:

Same as the above Tap Description, but must be choreographed and performed in a 3/4 or 6/8 time signature.

Speed Tap:

Same as the above Tap Description, but must be choreographed to a fast tempo and performed at that pace.

Slow Tap:

Same as the above Tap Description, but must be choreographed to a slow tempo and performed at that pace.

Street Tap:

Street tap is a modern style of tap dancing that blends traditional tap technique with a more urban, grounded, and freestyle feel. It keeps the rhythm, musicality and footwork of classic tap but adds street/urban influences (hip hop groove, relaxed posture, attitude). It incorporates lower centre of gravity, more use of slides/shuffles/toe drops/heel work and a strong focus on groove and rhythm over upright presentation.

Song & Dance Tap:

Tap technique must be used in this division. The singing elements and dance segment of the routine should be evenly balanced and equally strong.

- No voice backing vocals allowed during the song component.
- Voice over/backing vocals are allowed during the dance component.

Song & Dance:

Any genre of dance technique (except tap when there is a Song & Dance Tap option) may be used in this division. The singing elements and dance segment of the routine should be evenly balanced and equally strong.

- No voice backing vocals allowed during the song component.
- Voice over/backing vocals are allowed during the dance component.

Musical Theatre:

A live presentation from a stage or film Musical.

- **Must include live singing, a line of dialogue** and dance moves.
- Must be presented in the style from a stage or screen musical.
- Must have no vocal backing in the entire track
- Must have no spoken vocal words in the entire track
- Can not be presented in a song & dance format.

Cabaret:

A routine with emphasis placed on entertainment value, with characteristics of what one might expect to see at a nightclub or a restaurant.

- Performance and costuming must be family friendly.

Broadway Jazz:

Routine should be based on Jazz Technique, stylized using exaggeration, quirkiness and athleticism so that the movement is story and character driven.

Jazz Up Tempo:

A routine comprised primarily of Jazz technique, performed to Up Tempo Music.

Hip Hop:

Consists of Street, Funk, MTV video style Jazz techniques.

Lyrical:

Consists of Jazz and Ballet technique, with an emphasis placed on strength, control and musical interpretation. Should include emotional and storytelling elements.

Neo Classical:

Comprised of Ballet technique and Classical lines of movement. There may, however, be a minimal diversion from the Ballet aesthetic to include some parallel work, flexed feet and angular arm lines.

Contemporary:

Consists of Modern and Ballet technique, reaching beyond the standard Jazz Vocabulary. Should be primarily based on recognized methods such as:

- Cunningham Technique
- Graham Technique
- Horton Technique
- Limon Technique

Using concepts such as; contraction, release, gravity and weight, swing, rebound, fall, recovery and suspension.

Classical:

Routine must be comprised of Ballet technique incorporating formal classical movements and lines.

- No repertoire allowed.
- Acrobatic/gymnastic tricks are not allowed in this category.

Character or Demi-Character:

A genre based on Classical Ballet technique, where the storyline and/or portrayal of a character must be as strong and equal to the dance component.

No repertoire allowed.

National:

Must represent a country and its traditions, using authentic music, steps and costuming.

Acrobatic:

A routine containing acrobatic movement/gymnastics: routine must contain 50% dance choreography. May contain contortion work.

Novelty:

A Routine that includes innovative dance movements that incorporate a theme, concept or characterization throughout the entire performance.

Own Choreography:

Routine has been choreographed by the dancer who is performing it.

Improvisation:

Involves creating and executing movement spontaneously, without any premeditated movement.

COVID

Whilst the event is on we will require everyone to follow the covid safe plan for Queensland live venues and theatres. We will also require all tickets to be purchased from the Civic Centre box office for our group event. Our solo event tickets will be purchased inside the auditorium as per previous years.

- Studios/Schools must repeat the dance performance given the highest adjudication score by the Adjudicator. In the event where the same high score is given for more than one dance – it will be the Studio/schools choice between those dances. (Note all age groups are included).
- Studios/schools perform only one (1) dance each in the High Score Champion items.
- Competitors are to perform in the order selected by the Convenor.
- Finalist lists will be posted on our Facebook page at conclusion of the group/high school sections and available at the entry door.
- All Groups High Score Champion finals will be performed on the evening of – **Monday June 22nd**
