AGE –

Age as of 1st day of competition – 16th September 2023

All dancers must be at or under the age as 16th September 2023.

Duo / Trio – Age as of 1st January 2023

CLOSING DATE -

Sunday 4th August 2023 Entries may close early dependant on entries. Notification of early close will be made on Inspire Dance & Fitness socials.

LATE ENTRIES -

Late entries MAY (not guaranteed) be accepted and will incur an extra \$10 flat late fee. Late entries may be required to dance first. Notification of availability will be made through socials.

TIME LIMITS – 3 mins max. including reprise NOTE: Reprise is not essential Should a performance go overtime by more than 10 seconds a deduction of 4 points will occur. Music / Act will be timed from 1st movement / 1st sound to last movement / sound.

PROMPTING -

No prompting from side stage or in the audience is permitted for competitors 8u + - this can lead to disqualification. Babies (3&4years) & 6u may have prompting – prefer to be done from the mid / back of the venue – this is to avoid little ones turning their heads to view side stage. **CHANGE OF SECTIONS** – Please be Honest with entries - Should you need to change your category ie Restricted to Open or 1st Time to Restricted due to a win since entering please email

<u>peta@inspiredancefitness.com.au</u> with all relevant details.

PROPS -

- If reasonable to do so the dancers should set up & remove own props.

- Props are not to be stored in the hall throughout the day without previous permission. They can be placed backstage or front of house at the beginning of each section and must be removed immediately after use.

- No flammables or live flames are to be used.

- No use of live animals

If you use petals, snowflakes, glitter, paper, loose feathers etc and it makes a mess on the stage YOU must clean it quickly & immediately after your act.
If a prop is thrown from the stage / performance area into the audience and is deemed a hazard / dangerous this may lead to disqualification.
ALL FREE STANDING PROPS MUST HAVE PROTECTIVE CAPS ON THE LEGS / BASE TO PREVENT DAMAGE TO TARKETT / FLOORS.

TAP SHOES -

Please AVOID wearing tap shoes throughout the ENTIRE VENUE & the hall (request of venues & courtesy to other patrons)

ARRIVAL -

Competitors are encouraged to arrive at least an hour before to ensure adequate warmup, set up, registration & incase we are running early. Constant updates will be made on socials.

PROTESTS -

Protests will only be accepted in writing, accompanied with a \$10 fee within 10mins of completion of section / award ceremony. The protest must be handed to an IAC Official who will communicate with convenor & adjudicator.

ADJUDICATORS -

Under no circumstances should the Adjudicator be approached by anyone at the desk. This can lead to disqualification of associated studio / act.

DUTY OF CARE -

Whilst we take all reasonable care with our events it is the responsibility of studio Directors /

teachers/ parents that students / children remain in permitted areas and are behaving appropriately. All competitors & spectators enter at their own risk. No responsibility will be taken for any accidents, injury or loss of property. This also applies to cars parked in the venue grounds.

REFUNDS -

- Once entries have been accepted there will be no refunds unless the section is cancelled. You may transfer entries to another event.

- CoVid Refund Guarantee – should IAC have to be cancelled due to CoVid (government or venue cancellation) we will refund your entry fees minus your Comps OnLine Booking Fee or we can transfer to another event.

SMOKING -

Smoking is prohibited inside venue & on grassed areas outside doors. You must exit the venue gate in order to smoke. This is a rule & regulation from the venue. Failure to abide by this rule may lead to disqualification of associated competitors or if caught by venue staff / security may incur a direct fine.

Music Uploads Management is coming to us, we will now be using this service for our

As a requirement to enter into the competition you will be required to upload your music via this service," in the given time period" no other options will be given.

Region Add-ons

For each competition that is entered, you will need to add a region to your cloud account. This will link the Music, Critiques and Videos so they can be transferred or viewed from one to the other. The fee for this is per Family, Studio or School is \$2.50, and there is no limit to siblings or students, it will just depend on your selected storage plan.

How it works

- If you have already uploaded your music to this service before, you can simply purchase the region add-on, and transfer your music over to us.
- If you are new to this, you need to set up the cloud storage account first and confirm it is active.
- Upload your Music into the Storage Folder in your account.
- Transfer a copy of the songs to the Region, you can check them to make sure they are all correct.
- Done! No need to stress about your music now, as you now can see the music is 100% ready to go.

<u>Just Remember</u>, It is the responsibility of the competitors to ensure that they have the correct music files uploaded to each routine. You can change your music files at any time before the cutoff dates, and this is all done within your Music Uploads account, you have full control over this from now.

Critiques and Videos

Critiques will be uploaded either on the day or after the event has finished. To access these, log into you Music Uploads account and on the main dashboard page look to the top Left of the screen or on a mobile device click on the Menu list. If the onsite video company is collaborating with Music Uploads they will deliver your videos directly into your storage account.

Support

If you would like some support there are videos located on the support page or you can send a ticket in, and one of the team members will respond to you. DO NOT Post on Social Media , Text or Message any questions to these pages, as the support team will not see them You must send a ticket from the support page so they can offer you some assistance.

Restricted – Will include the usual Specially Restricted & if you place 1st in SR you will go to Restricted
 Open – Is for performers who have placed 1st in Restricted

◆ NOTE – Remember just because you get a new routine or go up an age it does not mean you start at the beginning again in SR or R.

WHAT IS 1st TIME ON STAGE? – As the name implies it is for soloists who are competing for the 1st time as a soloist. They perform ANY GENRE in that section OR you can enter in the general style specific.

WHAT IS DANCEABILITY? — There is only one age category. DanceAbility is a section for performers with intellectual or physical disability.

WHAT IS BEST IAC COMMERCIAL DANCER? Best IAC Commercial Dancer is decided based on the best average score out of your 3 commercial routines – Jazz, Hip Hop, Own Choice (See Above). Please note you can enter 2 routines max. in 1 section. Junior (6u, 8u), Intermediate (10u, 12u), Senior (14u, 15+). In the event of a tie the Adjudicator will decide. Winner will win a Trophy /Plaque and a great Supporter Pack.

WHAT IS BEST IAC TECHNICAL DANCER? Best Technical Dancer is decided based on the best average score out of your 3 technical routines – Lyrical, Contemporary, Own Choice (See Above). Please note you can enter 2 routines in 1 section. Junior (6u, 8u), Intermediate (10u, 12u), Senior (14u, 15+). In the event of a tie the Adjudicator will decide. Winner will win a Trophy / Plaque and a great Supporter Pack.
