

Genre Definitions / Descriptions

Ballet – may include Romantic Ballet, Classical Ballet, Neoclassical Ballet and can utilise non-traditional music as long as the technique and foundation remains true to style.

<u>Tap</u> – rhythmic tap styles – Slow, Waltz, Fast, Speed, Ensemble have been combined for Troupes.

<u>Jazz / Hip Hop (Babies)</u> – This style can include straight jazz, or a combination of traditional jazz basics fused with JFH/HipHop

Jazz - Straight jazz styles.

<u>Hip Hop</u> – JFH and street styles which can include a fusion of sub genres such as pop'n'lock, breakdance, whacking, vogueing, dancehall etc.

Lyrical – is commonly (but not necessary) performed to music with lyrics and movements are inspired by lyrics to express strong emotions or a story the choreographer/performer feels from the lyrics in the chosen song.

Contemporary – contemporary dance tends to combine the strong and controlled legwork of ballet with modern dance's stress on the torso, and also employs abstraction, contract-release, floor work, fall and recovery, and improvisation characteristic of modern dance. Unpredictable changes in rhythm, speed, and direction are often used, as well. It sometimes also incorporates elements of non-western dance cultures.

Musical Theatre – must be performed to a piece of music from a musical and preferable (but not essential) to encompass dance style from musical. Can include live vocals, mime or simply dance.

Variety — this section is open to all styles / genres and acts that do not typically fit into one of the IAC categories. Ie demi character, acrobatics, cheer, pom, circus skills, contortion, musicians, comedy, cultural dance, ballroom dance, vocalist with backing dancers, vocalist/musician etc. The sky is the limit – as long as it is entertaining and age appropriate.

DanceAbility – 2026 will be the 4th year we are inviting DanceAbility Groups to perform. All performers in DanceAbility sections will receive a Participation Pin. This section is created for students who may have physical or intellectual disabilities. Helpers / carers are welcome to perform with their group.

This is about PERFORMANCE & INCLUSION rather than COMPETITION.

Student Choreography (Education Day) – this act can be any style, must be solely choreographed by the student. Can be danced as a solo/duo/trio – class compositions permitted.

Group Improvisation (Education Day) – dancers all hit the floor at once or in groups (dependant on entries). Various genres. Gold Coin Donation made on the day. Will run time permitting. ALL money raised will go to our chosen charity. Split in stages and open to Year 3 – 12.

Rules & Conditions

AGE -

Studio Troupes – Age as of 1st January 2026
All dancers must be the age or under as of 1st Jan 2026.
In a Troupe you may have ONLY 2 dancers in 1 (one) age bracket above. Please NOTE – Proof of ID may be requested if there is a query / protest

Educational Schools – are categorized in Stages. If you are a mix of stages, you should be entering in highest stage. If unsure please email Peta on inspiredancefitness.pmw@gmail.com with numbers and to verify.

LATE ENTRIES – Late entries <u>may</u> (not guaranteed) be accepted and will incur an extra \$10 flat rate. Late entries may be required to dance first. Notification will be made through email and social media if some space available.

WE ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR INCORRECT ENTRIES, BUT HAPPY TO AMMEND IF NOTIFIED BEFORE FINAL PROGRAM. ONCE ENTRIES HAVE BEEN ACCEPTED, NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN UNLESS THE SECTION IS CANCELLED.

MEDIA RELEASE – When you enter IAC you give consent for INSPIRE Dance & Fitness / IAC & affiliated IAC Supporters to use and retain the name & image of your child / students for the purposes of public relations, media & promotion in print or through the IDF / IAC FB & insta pages. This consent will remain for 5 years unless you advise otherwise. If you have any questions or

TIME LIMITS

Troupes 4 mins max Solos (Education) 3 mins max

Should a performance go over time by more than 10secs a deduction of 4 points will occur

Music / Act will be timed from 1st movement / 1st sound to last movement / last sound

PROMPTING – No prompting from side stage or in the audience is permitted for competitors 7yrs+ - this can lead to disqualification.

Babies (3-4years) & 6u may have prompting – prefer to be done from out the front to avoid dancers looking sideways throughout the dance – we want to see their beautiful faces!!

AGE APPROPRIATENESS - Our event is designed for families, welcoming dancers and audience members of all ages. It is essential that the music selection, choreography, and costumes are deemed ageappropriate. Our adjudicator reserves the right to impose penalties if any studios or educational institutions present performances that may cross this line – adjudicator discretion.

PROPS - If reasonable to do so competitors should set up and remove their own props

Props are not to be stored in dressing rooms or main performance space. They can be stored behind the black stage divider on Troupe Day. Please see IAC Volunteer to be steered in the right direction.

- * No flammables or live flames are to be used
- * No use of live animals
- * If you use petals, snowflakes, glitter, paper, loose feathers etc and it makes a mess on the stage please notify backstage manager as you may need to dance last. You MUST clean quickly & immediately after your act.
- * If a prop is thrown from stage / performance space into the audience and is deemed a hazard / dangerous this may lead to disqualification ie a ball being thrown into audience could cause injury
- * All free standing props / structures / canes etc must have protective caps or rubber on the legs / base to prevent damage to the floors. Any props causing damage to the floor may incur penalty – if they are at risk of causing damage, they may not be able to be used.

TAP SHOES – Please avoid wearing tap shoes throughout the entire venue & the hall (request of venue & courtesy to other patrons).

At Troupe Weekend entry / exit will be along a runner through the tunnel. DO NOT WALK ON THE STADIUM FLOOR IN TAP SHOES. A map will be included in program.

STAGE SIZE – 12m wide x 8m deep Tarkett floor space As Tarkett is laid on basketball court dancers can dance off the space without fear of deduction (except in tap shoes). Dancers must just be mindful of media wall wings & speakers.

ARRIVAL - Competitors are encouraged to arrive at least an hour before to ensure set up, adequate warm-up and in case we are running early. IAC is not responsible for giving you individual arrival times.

PROTESTS – will be accepted in writing, accompanied with a \$10 fee within 10mins of the completion of awards for that section. The protest must be handed in to an IAC Official who will make contact with convenor & Adjudicator.

ADJUDICATORS should not be approached by a teacher, performer or parent whilst they are at the desk. This can lead to disqualification of associated competitor/s. Any correspondence should be made through an IAC Official

SHOES should be worn at all times when walking through the venue & outside for your own protection. You cannot be assured what can be on the ground.

RISK – All competitors & spectators enter at their own risk. No responsibility will be taken for any accident, injury or loss of property. This also applies to cars parked on the venue grounds. IDF/IAC/PVRSC will do their utmost to provide a safe and secure space for all who attend.

OUT OF SECTION – Competitors cannot dance out of section unless they dance for REPORT ONLY or it has been organized with IAC Convenor.

SMOKING / VAPEING – is prohibited inside the venue & on grassed areas, therefore you must head to the carparks or outside the grounds. This is a request from PVRSC. Failure to abide by this rule may lead to disqualification of associated competitor/s

VENUE / PATRON RESPECT – We ask that all competitors & spectators pay respect to the venue/PVRSC by keeping it clean & tidy, putting rubbish in bins provided, following rules, respectful of staff members & other PVRSC patrons. Failure to abide by these simple requests may lead to disqualification or you may be asked to leave the venue by a PVRSC staff member.

DRESSING ROOMS – Studios / Educational Schools will be allocated a dressing space based on numbers & how many performances. Spaces are shared so please be respectful to one another. It is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY to keep this space clean during your stay. Please clean up before you leave. Unfortunately, in 2024 we were left with a huge cleaning bill due to people not abiding by NO FOOD OR DRINKS in dressing rooms. 2026 will have cleaning fee passed on the studios / educational schools

should they be eating / drinking in the space or their dressing space left in an inappropriate state. NOTE Changing Tents are provided for dancers behind the performance space for privacy.

SPECIAL NOTE – Due to circumstances & requests, NO MALE TEACHERS, PARENTS, or DANCERS (12 yrs+) are allowed in the main dressing rooms. Male dancers may enter if all female dancers have changed, and they have received explicit permission from other patrons. There is plenty of room at the venue to have chats, talks, rehearsals, eat etc.

IF FATHERS NEED TO ASSIST CHILD WITH DRESSING PLEASE EITHER SEE PETA TO MAKE ALTERNATE SPACE ARRANGMENTS OR ASK ANOTHER PARENT IF THEY CAN ASSIST.

We are following guidelines set out by NSW Childrens Guardian, PVRSC & Request of Other Patrons

PRIZES - at Adjudicators discretion

ALL Studio Troupes & Educational Schools will receive a Certificate of Participation & Studio Directors / Head School Teacher will receive an IAC Pin.

<u>Troupes – 1st</u>, 2nd, 3rd awards for Studio / School (dependent on entries) + HC certificates & IAC Performer place pins. Some sections may have Sponsored / Supporter Prizes which may include cash, vouchers, products, experiences etc

Educational School Soloists - 1st, 2nd, 3rd awards for soloist (dependent on entries) + HC certificates & IAC Participation Pins for ALL soloists. Some sections may have Sponsored / Supporter Prizes which may include cash, vouchers, products, experiences etc Educational School Group Elimination Improvisation – (will run if time permits) – 1st, 2nd, 3rd awards for dancers + HC (dependent on entries)

Most Entertaining Troupe - Jnr & Snr - all entered troupes will be in the running to be the Adjudicators Most Entertaining Troupe. Win Certificate, Prize Pack & Title. Highest Point Score Troupe - Jnr & Snr - all entered troupes will be in the running to win the Highest Point Score. Win Certificate, Prize Pack & Title. Most Entertaining Educational Troupe - Primary & Secondary – all entered educational troupes will be in the running to be the Adjudicators Most Entertaining Educational Troupe. Win Certificate, Prize Pack & Title. Highest Point Score Educational Troupe - Primary & Secondary – all entered educational troupes will be in the running to win the Highest Point Score. Win Certificate, Prize Pack & Title. OTHER AWARDS MAY ARISE & WILL BE PROMOTED THROUGH SOCIAL MEDIA.

VIDEO / PHOTOGRAPHY – In order to raise more funds for our chosen charity THE STEELE FOUNDATION we are allowing representatives from the studio / educational school to take photos / videos of THEIR ACTS ONLY for a GOLD COIN DONATION FOR EACH ACT / PERSON RECORDING FROM THE DESIGNATED SPOT ONLY. We are relying on your honesty.

People should not be encroaching on the Adjudicator and nor should they be taking pics/video from their seat in the grandstand. Failure to comply with these rules may lead to disqualification of associated competitor/s. IT IS IMPORTANT YOU LET PARENTS KNOW – ESPECIALLY EDUCATION SCHOOLS AS THEY OFTEN DO NOT UNDERSTAND PROTOCOL OF A COMPETITION. Please share videos / images on your socials & tag @inspiredancefitness

MEDIA WALL will be made available for all students / parents and teachers to have their photos taken with their awards & friends. Do not forget to tag us @inspiredancefitness and any Supporters who you may have won a prize from.

CANTEEN & FOOD TRUCKS – A fully stocked canteen will be available for performers & patrons from the start of the day to approx. 2-3 hours before completion of the day or as they feel is needed. Food trucks (TBC) will also be present on Troupe Day.

Voice critiques and all in one storage location. As a requirement to enter into the competition you will be required to upload your music via this service," in the given time period" no other options will be given. No CDs, USB's will be used now as we are using this system totally contactless.

Music Uploads offer this service and include features that will handle our music. This is a low cost paid service, (less than the cost of a USB) and includes a full range of benefits for The Dancers, Parents, and Studio owners, and event organisers. You will be required to have a valid "music uploads cloud storage" this will allow you, to store your Music, Voice Critiques, and Routine Videos all in one location. Plans are charged at a Minimum of 3 to 12 months starting at less than \$1/month, Plus your music can be transferred to other participating competitions all over Australia without having to re upload your music each time.

Region Add-ons

For each competition that is entered, you will need to add a region to your cloud account. This will link the Music, Critiques and Videos so they can be transferred or viewed from one to the other. The fee for this is per Family, Studio or School is \$2.50, and there is no limit to siblings or students, it will just depend on your selected storage plan.

How it works

- If you have already uploaded your music to this service before, you can simply purchase the region add-on and transfer your music over to us.
- If you are new to this, you need to set up the cloud storage account first and confirm it is active.
- Upload your Music into the Storage Folder in your account.
- Transfer a copy of the songs to the Region, you can check them to make sure they are all correct.
- Done! No need to stress about your music now, as you now can see the music is 100% ready to go.

<u>Just Remember</u>, it is the responsibility of the competitors to ensure that they have the correct music files uploaded to each routine. You can change your music files at any time before the cutoff dates, and this is all done within

your Music Uploads account, you have full control over this from now.

Critiques and Videos

Critiques will be uploaded either on the day or after the event has finished. To access these, log into you Music Uploads account and on the main dashboard page look to the top Left of the screen or on a mobile device click on the Menu list.

Support

If you would like some support there are videos located on the support page or you can send a ticket in, and one of the team members will respond to you. DO NOT Post on Social Media , Text or Message any questions to these pages, as the support team will not see them You must send a ticket from the support page so they can offer you some assistance.
