

^{*} Restricted - includes the usual Specially Restricted & if you place 1st in SR you go to Restricted

^{*} Open - for performers who have placed 1st in Restricted

^{*} NOTE - just because you get a new routine or go up an age it does not mean you go back to Restricted. Once in Open for that genre - always in Open!

Category Descriptions

WHAT IS 1st TIME ON STAGE? - As the name implies it is for dancers competing for the 1st time as a soloist. They can perform ANY GENRE in this section. They are permitted to perform their routine 1x previously at another competition.

WHAT IS DANCEABILITY? – There is only one age category. DanceAbility is a section for performers with intellectual or physical disability. DanceAbility = 2026 will be the 4th year we are inviting DanceAbility dancers to perform. All performers in DanceAbility sections will receive a Participation Pin. Helpers / carers are welcome to perform with their dancer. This is about PERFORMANCE & INCLUSION rather than COMPETITION.

WHAT IS INSPIRE COVER STAR? - Inspire Cover Star is a photographic section. Dance is an artform and to capture emotion, lines, movement in a photograph takes skill from the photographer & dancer. For Only \$10 you can enter a series of images – 2 dance shots & 1 headshot. Dance shots can NOT HAVE BRANDING FROM OTHER COMPS and they do not have to be taken by a professional photographer. They could be studio, posed, movement or outdoor shots. Headshot can be natural or fully made up. Can be colour or black & white. 4 categories - Babies (3-4years), Junior (6u, 8u), Intermediate (10u, 12u), Senior (14u, 15+). How will it be judged? What resonates with the adjudicator. Does it stir emotion. Are lines clean. Creativeness.

What will they win? A medal, certificate and Supporter Prize.

Please note you can enter 2 routines in 1 section. In the event of a tie the Adjudicator will decide. Winner will win a Trophy /Plaque, Tiara, Certificate and a Supporter Pack thanks to our Sponsors. YOU SIMPLY ENTER 3 DIFFERENT COMMERCIAL GENRES TO QUALIFY – NO EXTRA FEE!!!!

WHAT IS BEST IAC TECHNICAL DANCER? - Best IAC Technical Dancer is decided based on the best average score out of your 3 Technical routines – Lyrical, Contemporary & Own Choice Technical Choice (See Above).

How To Qualify – MUST ENTER LYRICAL & CONTEMPORARY and own choice routine can be another Lyrical, Contemporary OR Ballet, Demi, student choreography in technical genre. Please note you can enter 2 routines in 1 section. In the event of a tie the Adjudicator will decide. Winner will win a Trophy /Plaque, Tiara, Certificate and a great Supporter Pack thanks to our Sponsors. YOU SIMPLY ENTER 3 DIFFERENT GENRES TO QUALIFY – NO EXTRA FEE!!!!!

WHAT IS VOCAL CHAMPIONSHIP? - We're so excited to re-introduce Vocals to Inspire Arts Challenge as we celebrate our milestone 10th Anniversary — and what better way to bring it back than with our Vocal Championship! WHAT IS GROUP IMPROVISATION? - Dancers all hit the floor at once or in groups (dependant on entries). Various genres. Gold Coin Donation made on the day with all money going to THE STEELE FOUNDATION. Will run if time permits on the day. So please bring GOLD COIN (for each genre), suitable dance attire & creativity – NO COSTUMES – just regular dance attire.

2026 IAC Rules & Conditions

AGE – Age as of 1st day of competition – 17th July 2026

All dancers must be at or under the age as 17th July 2026.

Duo / Trio - Age as of 1st January 2026

CLOSING DATE - 29th June 2026

Entries may close early dependant on entries. Notification of early close will be made on Inspire Dance & Fitness socials.

LATE ENTRIES - Late entries MAY (not guaranteed) be accepted and will incur an extra \$10 flat late fee. Late entries may be required to dance first. Notification of availability will be made through socials.

TIME LIMITS -

Babies, 6u, 8u, 10u - 2.5 mins with a 10sec leeway before point deductions

12u, 14u, 15+ - 3mins max before point deduction Music / Act will be timed from 1st movement / 1st sound to last movement / sound.

PROMPTING -

No prompting from side stage or in the audience is permitted for competitors 8u plus - this can lead to disqualification. Babies (3&4years) & 6u may have prompting – prefer to be done from the mid / back of the venue – this is to avoid little ones turning their heads to view side stage. Must not be in view of Adjudicator as to avoid distraction.

CHANGE OF SECTIONS – Please be honest with entries - Should you need to change your category ie Restricted to Open or 1st Time to Restricted please email inspiredancefitness.pmw@gmail.com with all relevant details.

PROPS -

- If reasonable to do so the dancers should set up & remove own props.
- Props are not to be stored in the hall throughout the day without previous permission. They can be placed backstage or front of house at the beginning of each section and must be removed immediately after use.
- No flammables or live flames are to be used.
- No use of live animals
- If you use petals, snowflakes, glitter, paper, loose feathers etc and it makes a mess on the stage YOU must clean it quickly & immediately after your act. Please notify backstage manager as we may ask you to dance last.
- If a prop is thrown from the stage / performance area into the audience and is deemed a hazard / dangerous this may lead to disqualification.
- ALL FREE STANDING PROPS MUST HAVE PROTECTIVE CAPS / RUBBER / FELT ON THE LEGS / BASE TO PREVENT DAMAGE TO TARKETT / FLOORS.

TAP SHOES -

Please AVOID wearing tap shoes throughout the ENTIRE VENUE & the hall (request of venues & courtesy to other patrons) Use covers or put on side stage.

ARRIVAL -

Competitors are encouraged to arrive at least an hour before to ensure adequate warmup, set up, registration & incase we are running early. We will endeavor to provide updates on socials. Please note we can not give individuals estimated arrival times. Check with your teacher if unsure how to work it out.

PROTESTS -

Protests will only be accepted in writing, accompanied with a \$10 fee within 10mins of completion of section / award ceremony. The protest must be handed to an IAC Official who will communicate with convenor & adjudicator.

ADJUDICATORS -

Under no circumstances should the Adjudicator be approached by anyone at their desk. This can lead to disqualification of associated studio / act.

DUTY OF CARE -

Whilst we take all reasonable care with our events it is the responsibility of studio Directors / teachers/ parents that students / children remain in permitted areas and are behaving appropriately.

All competitors & spectators enter at their own risk. No responsibility will be taken for any accidents, injury or loss of property. This also applies to cars parked in the venue grounds.

REFUNDS -

- Once entries have been accepted there will be no refunds unless the section is cancelled. You may transfer entries to another event.
- CoVid Refund Guarantee should IAC have to be cancelled due to CoVid (government or venue cancellation) we will refund your entry fees minus your Comps OnLine Booking Fee or we can transfer to another event.

SMOKING-

Smoking and vaping is prohibited inside venue & on school premises. You must exit the venue gate in order to smoke or vape. This is a rule & regulation from the venue. Failure to abide by this rule may lead to disqualification of associated competitors or if caught by venue staff / security may incur a direct fine.

VIDEOGRAPHY / PHOTOGRAPHY – In order to raise more funds for THE STEELE FOUNDATION we are allowing 2 (two) representatives from each act to take photos &/or video. ONLY THEIR ACTS.

Must offer a GOLD COIN (minimum) DONATION FOR EACH ACT. Money to be put in money container in designated area.

Representatives MUST STAND / SIT IN DESIGNATED AREA.

There is to be NO PHOTOGRAPHY / VIDEOGRAPHY FROM THE AUDIENCE. Failure to comply to these rules may lead to disqualification.

MUSIC-

Music Uploads Management is coming to us, we will now be using this service for our

competitions. It's contactless, all online, and will help take out the stress of music issues that arise from time to time, Plus they offer Voice critiques and all in one storage location including the option to access the routine videos. As a requirement to enter into the competition you will be required to upload your music via this service," in the given time period" no other options will be given.

No CDs ,USB's will be used now as we are using this system totally contactless.

Music Uploads offer this service and include features that will handle our music. This is a low cost paid service, (less than the cost of a USB) and includes a full range of benefits for The Dancers, Parents, and Studio owners, and event organisers. You will be required to have a valid "music uploads cloud storage" this will allow you, to store your Music, Voice Critiques, and Routine Videos all in one location. Plans are charged at a Minimum of 3 to 12 months starting at less than \$1/month, Plus your music can be transferred to other participating

competitions all over Australia without having to re upload your music each time.

Region Add-ons

For each competition that is entered, you will need to add a region to your cloud account. This will link the Music, Critiques and Videos so they can be transferred or viewed from one to the other. The fee for this is per Family, Studio or School is \$2.50, and there is no limit to siblings or students, it will just depend on your selected storage plan.

How it works

- If you have already uploaded your music to this service before, you can simply purchase the region add-on, and transfer your music over to us.
- If you are new to this, you need to set up the cloud storage account first and confirm it is active.
- Upload your Music into the Storage Folder in your account.
- Transfer a copy of the songs to the Region, you can check them to make sure they are all correct.
- Done! No need to stress about your music now, as you now can see the music is 100% ready to go.

Just Remember, It is the responsibility of the competitors to ensure that they have the correct music files uploaded to each routine. You can change your music files at any time before the cutoff dates, and this is all done within your Music Uploads account, you have full control over this from now.

Critiques and Videos

Critiques will be uploaded either on the day or after the event has finished. To access these, log into you Music Uploads account and on the main dashboard page look to the top Left of the screen or on a mobile device click on the Menu list.

If the onsite video company is collaborating with Music Uploads they will deliver your videos directly into your storage account.

Support

If you would like some support there are videos located on the support page or you can send a ticket in, and one of the team members will respond to you. DO NOT Post on Social Media, Text or Message any questions to these pages, as the support team will not see them You must send a ticket from the support page so they can offer you some assistance.
