RULES:

- SOLOS/ DUOS /TRIOS -**AGE AT THE FIRST DAY OF THE MONTH OF THE COMP** (If comp is 15th May age will be as at 1st MAY)
- Please check section definitions for all sections
- TROUPES – **AVERAGE AGE AS AT THE FIRST DAY OF MONTH OF THE COMP** (If comp is 15th May age will be average age as of 1st MAY)
- All dancers / competitors compete at their own risk. Shine Bright Dance Challenge takes **NO** responsibility for any accidents, injury, or death to any persons associated with the eisteddfod, either as a competitor, volunteer, or a member of the public, at any time.
- The adjudicators decision is final... any teachers, parents and or competitors approaching the adjudicator will be disqualified and asked to leave the venue
- All competitors / parents give their permission for photos to be used by Shine Bright Dance Challenge for promotional material, this includes results etc. on social media
- **NO** videoing or photography is allowed from the audience. If caught doing so you will be asked to leave the venue.
- **NO REFUNDS – transfer may be offered**
- Due to child protection laws please use the change rooms provided.
- **NO** practising in the hall
- Event is an Alcohol FREE zone
- Tap shoes are to be covered
- Nobody to be back stage except competitors and carers of babies under 4's under 5's and also under 6's, unless helping with props
- No resin to be used
- All programs will be uploaded to social media and emailed unless other arrangements have been made
- Music is via Music Uploads (www.musicuploads.com.au)
- Spare copies on USB is a great idea as a back up
- Sections may be combined if needed due to lack of entries but adjudicated according to the level
- Music is to be relevant to the age of the performer
- Plain Leotard / crop top and bottoms to be worn for Impros
- Copy of child's birth certificate required on entry
- Prompting will not be permitted except for in the babies sections
- Impros will be danced in age sections only
- All competitors must perform in order of programme
- There is to be quiet in the hall at all times
- No dancer is to perform out of section

- Unfinished dances may be repeated at the discretion of the adjudicator except 12yrs and over.
- Shine Bright Dance Challenge reserves the right to change competition days or move location due to unforeseen circumstances
- Song and Dance routines – **NO** vocals allowed during singing sections
- Time Limits: Babies (U5) – 2.5mins, Solos – 3mins, Troupes 5mins
- Troupes – MINI , SMALL or LARGE (Mini 4- 7 sml 7 to 10 dancers Large 11 plus)
- **Covid 19 rules to be followed at all times**

- Medals for 1st 2nd and 3rd places in Impros with Certificates for HC
- (Medals may be used for 1st place if the comp is traveling far)
- All dancers 10 years and under place in all sections
- All dancers that place 1st 2nd or 3rd automatically qualify for State Champions

SOLO SECTION DEFINITIONS:

- **Specially Restricted** – For competitors who have never won that style of dance at any competitions
- **Restricted** – For competitors who have not won restricted in that style but have won in the specially restricted for that style (babies sections are not taken into count)
- **Open** – for competitors who have won specially restricted and restricted for that style. Or for competitors who dance more than 13hours per week
- **Advanced** – For students who take are part time or full time dancers and or dance / train more than 13hrs per week
- **Advance** – all part-time students (for dancers who train at their studio or attend dance / acro training or private coaching during school hours throughout the week)

- **Babies – Under 4's – Any Style**
- **Babies – Under 5's – Any Style** (section maybe spilt into styles depending on entries) (No more than 3 dances in the section from the one competitor. However welcome to enter additional dances in the under 6yrs sections)
- **Babies – Under 6's**

IMPROS

- **Tap, Jazz, Classical, Lyrical, Contemp and Hip Hop**
NOVICE OR OPEN (Novice meaning have never won before in that impro style)
 - Under 6, 8, 10, 12, 14 and 15yrs and over

CHAMPIONSHIPS

- Qualification for Championships :
 - Babies (U5) – 1x dance in any style * can be repeated
 - U6 - 1 x dance performed in the style section *can be repeated
 - All other Championships – 1 x dance performed in the style section plus 1x impro (can repeat)
- Babies Championship (U5) – Any style *can repeat
- Under 6 Championship *can repeat
 - Jazz - Lyrical -Contemp
 - Tap - Classical
- Under 8, 10, 12, 14, 15-16, and over 17yrs Championships * can repeat
- Must dance an impro in the same genre to qualify (1x routine plus 1x impro both in the same genre)
 - Jazz - Contemp - Classical
 - Lyrical - Tap - Hip Hop
- **NOVICE OR OPEN** – Novice meaning you have never won a championship in that style before (this is for all ages / styles as above)

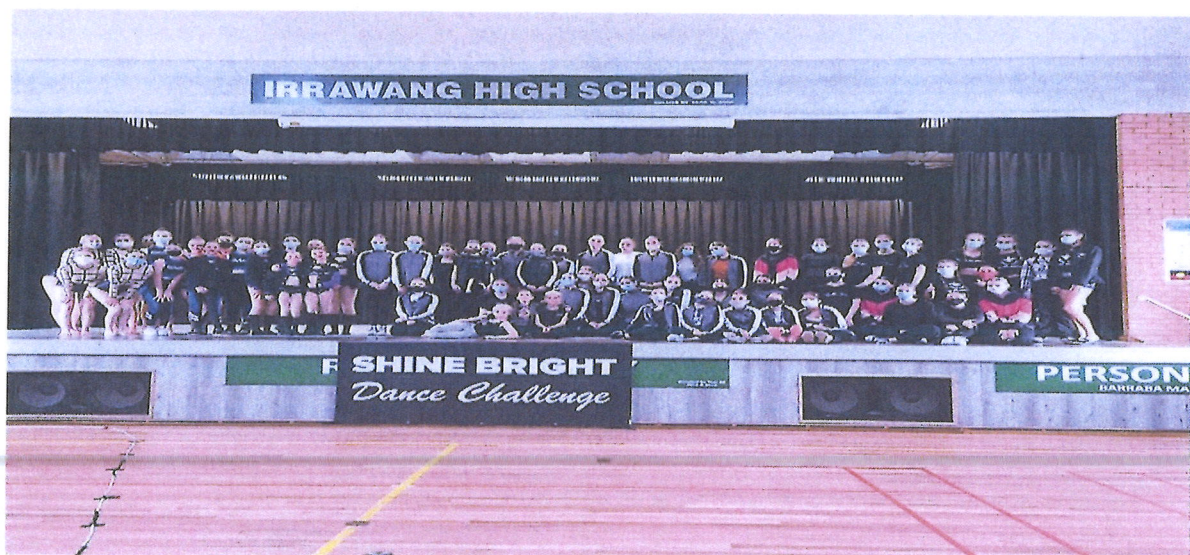
Any Style – under 5, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14 and 15-17 and over 18 years

TROUPES

- Troupes can be entered as novice troupes if the following applies... please write this on form below when emailing entry or be sure to select novice troupes when doing via comps online

Novice Troupes/ Beginners –

Troupes that are made up of all students new to competing (are in a performance / beginners class at studio) and have not competed in troupes for more than 18mths... The troupe also must not have been competing altogether for more than 18months. **NO ELITE** dancers can be in the Novice troupes
