CONDITIONS:

- 1. Age will be as at competition date June 1st 2025.
- 2. All entrants must be non-professional emerging composers.
- 3. Any style of piece may be written for any instrument or group of instruments/voice.
- 4. One piece may not be entered into two sections (i.e. different works for different sections).
- 5. <u>OPEN SECTIONS</u>: Senior, Open Senior Audio Visual (18 yrs & over) Open Junior/Open Junior Audio Visual (17 yrs & under- open to ALL areas).
- 6. Open Audio Visual criteria (Junior and Senior a visual stimulus must accompany the musical work i.e. power point, photo slideshow, film clip etc. The music may be played live, included with the visual component or played as a separate recording. This must not simply be a video of a live performance of the work but a creative visual accompaniment.
- 7. Judging in all sections is on COMPOSITION ONLY (i.e. not the actual performance or visual presentation)
- 8. Performance of works- entrants are encouraged to perform/or have the works performed live at the event (see 9 if you are unable to attend).
- 9. Entrants MUST PROVIDE a written/printed score for the judging at the competition.
- 10. If you are unable to attend/perform on the day, please upload your score and MP3 or MP4 via the competitor information form that will be sent to your email upon entry. All works are to be uploaded by Wed. May 28th
- 11. <u>Duration of composition</u> minimum of 16 bars maximum of 8 minutes.
- 12. Gold Coast Age sections and Special Awards the entrant must be taught by a Gold Coast based teacher.
- 13. <u>Regional/ Remote Junior</u> award areas per bureau of statistics (outer regional very remote) unless limited entries (inner remote will be included).
- 14. Entrants will be notified via email of section times 1-2 weeks prior to the competition (program will be published at www.gmta.org.au/gold-coast/ and available on the day).
- 15. ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED THROUGH COMPS ONLINE by Friday May 2nd https://www.comps-online.com.au
- 16. Prizes: 1st, 2nd, 3rd, HC awarded for each of the main sections (e.g. Gold Coast ages, and Open sections).
- 17. Trophies medallions and certificates will only be presented if the entrant is present on the day. Electronic copies of certificates and reports will be emailed post event. There will be no physical mailing of awards.
- 18. Special additional awards announced at the end of the competition/or via email/website.
- 19. "Popular Non Art Genres" is an Award description applying to non art music entries including but not limited to Pop, Rock, Jazz, country, rap etc.
