

INSTRUMENTAL SPECIAL RULES

To be read in conjunction with the general rules available on our website www.coffseisteddfod.org.au.

A separate copy of the music selection of each competitor must be provided for the adjudicator. Music must be clearly marked with the competitor name, section number and competitor number and handed to the librarian 20 minutes PRIOR to the commencement of the session.

- 1. A copy of the **COPYRIGHT DECLARATION FORM** must be completed. This is available at www.coffseisteddfod.org.au.
- 2. Any photocopied material will be retained by the committee to be destroyed according to copyright ruling.
- 3. All Competitors entering the Championship section must perform in two (2) other sections in their age group. That is three (3) sections altogether including the championship. Competitors may only enter in one (1) Championship section.
- 4. ACCOMPANIST- The accompanist for the instrumental section may be live piano or an instrumental backing track.
- 5. No accompaniment or teacher instrumental participation is allowed in Duets, Trios, Quartets or Ensembles. A teacher may conduct a primary school or high school instrumental ensemble.
- 6. Any section with less than 3 performers may be combined at the discretion of the Organising Secretary. (ie. age groups may be combined.)
- 7. There is an expectation that all competitors and audience members will stay for the entire section. There will be no talking or unnecessary movement during performances
- 8. There is to be <u>NO</u> photography and/or filming, including the use of mobile phones, during a performance.

Jason Noble

Jason Noble is one of Australia's most versatile clarinettists – experimental to classical – a soloist and core member of Ensemble Offspring. Jason has performed at festivals locally and internationally, from Warsaw to London, Shanghai to Kabul, and all major cities across Australia. "His expertise and virtuosic playing give new insights into the versatility of the bass clarinet" (Sounds Like Sydney)

His album releases include THRUM (2020) – a collection of improvised ambient sounds created with Kim Cunio on piano – and Chi's Cakewalk (2017), an album of new Australian works for clarinets. He has also made guest appearances on albums for Gurrumul, Sally Seltmann, ABC Classics, Gondwana Voices, Paul Mac, Halcyon, SICKO improvising orchestra, and the Tiwi women's choir Ngarukuruwala. Recently he performed at the Adelaide Festival in Incredible Floridas, curated by Kim Williams, appearing as soloist with the Australian String Quartet.

Jason collaborates with living and emerging composers, and is an in-demand music educator. He has been on staff at the Sydney Conservatorium of Music, and ANU School of Music. In 2022 he adjudicated multiple sessions at the Sydney Performing Arts Challenge. He has been invited to teach two winter academies at the Afghanistan National Institute of Music in Kabul, and maintains links with staff and students there. He is also a Woodwind examiner at grade and diploma level for the AMEB.
