

Please make sure to read all the Rules and Regulations.

STARSTRUCK aims to provide a safe environment where competitors, teachers and families are valued and encouraged in a positive manner by all staff, volunteers and industry professionals involved. We adhere to child safety policies and aim to provide you with genre specific adjudicators and age blocking where possible.

Media Release

When you enter STARSTRUCK you give consent for 2 years for STARSTRUCK to use and retain the name and image of your child for the purposes of public relations, media and promotion in print or through social media profiles. This consent will remain in place unless you advise otherwise.



Registration Fee - \$38 per competitor

The Registration Fee covers entry for all spectators to the venue/theatre, a digital program and all admin costs.

STRICTLY NO VIDEO OR PHOTOS TO BE TAKEN IN THE THEATRE. ANYONE CAUGHT DOING SO WILL BE ASKED TO DELETE THE FOOTAGE FROM THEIR DEVICE AND LEAVE THE COMPETITION IMMEDIATELY.

ALL SESSIONS WILL START AT THEIR SCHEDULED TIMES, REGARDLESS IF THE EVENT IS RUNNING EARLY.

- Ages are to be taken as at 1st January 2023.
- Part-time or Full-time dancers are eligible to enter but must register as Open Age.
- Starstruck Dance Competition will not issue any refunds, credits or exchanges for any sections entered where the competitor is no longer able to attend, has been entered incorrectly, has become injured or has been disqualified.
- Please ensure you read all the rules carefully before entering this event. The "lack of understanding" of any rules will not be accepted as a reason for the reason any rule is broken.
- A novice is a competitor who has never placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in a section in any age group.
- Starstruck Dance Competition reserves the right to refuse entry.
- All entries must be completed honestly. The organisers, volunteers or any representatives
 of STARSTRUCK will not be held liable for the mis-entry of a competitor entered through
 comps-online.
- Late entries will be accepted if the event has not reached capacity. A late entry fee of \$10 per routine will be applicable.
- Changes to entries may be possible but only **PRIOR** to the program being finalised.
- **Championship sections** may showcase a repeat performance or a new routine. All competitor's must be entered into, and perform in the Open section of the style Championship they are entering.
- The Adjudicator's decision is final. Communication with the Adjudicator at any time during the competition by any person other than the Organiser and Volunteers is not permitted. Anyone breaching this rule will be disqualified from the competition and will not receive a refund.
- Any protest against a decision or competitor must be made within 30 minutes of the *SUBJECT TO CHANGE

completion of the section. A \$20 fee is payable upon protest request and will not be refunded regardless of the outcome. This fee is to cover the cost of the time and resources needed to look into the protest.

- The Organiser reserves the right to appoint a substitute Adjudicator if necessary.

 Please note all Adjudicators are carefully selected for their expertise and experience.
- Competitors must perform the work of the school whose name appears on the entry form and must not have received any regular tuition from the Adjudicator for a period of 3 months prior to this competition.

If you dance at more than one school, you are only eligible to enter under the school from which you learnt your routine. Competitors may appear only once in any section or age group.

- No rehearsal is permitted on stage. A competitor who leaves the stage before completing their dance may reappear at the end of the section for a crit only. There will not be a front curtain at this competition.
- The Organiser reserves the right to join any sections where insufficient entries are received. Sections will be split if 20 or more competitors are entered into. Section. Where only one competitor presents they will be adjudicated to such standard as the Adjudicator deems appropriate.
- COMPETITORS ARE REQUIRED TO BOOK IN AT LEAST 3 SECTIONS BEFORE THEIR SECTION COMMENCES. PLEASE CHECK YOUR EMAIL FOR THE CHECK-IN DESK LOCATION FOR YOUR VENUE.
- Please note: STARSTRUCK may run up to 1hr ahead of time.

MAXIMUM Time Limits:

Solo/Duo/Trio Sections 3 minutes.

Song & Dance/Tap 4 minutes

Vocal Sections 3 minutes

Championship Sections 3 minutes

- Time limits will be strictly enforced. The time of the item will be taken from when the music commences until the competitor exits the stage.
- STARSTRUCK believes in creating an inclusive and family friendly environment. For this
 reason, males of any age will not be restricted from the main dressing room area. Where

possible a boys only and family's only dressing room will be allocated for anyone not comfortable dressing in the main dressing room area.



Performances should be designed to be safe for the performer and be family friendly.
 Music selected should be age appropriate and free from any explicit language. If explicit language is used, the music will be stopped immediately, the competitor will be asked to leave the stage and be disqualified from the section.

PLEASE NOTE: ALL COMPETITORS MUST WEAR STOCKINGS AT THIS COMPETION. KNEE PROTECTION IS COMPULSORY IF THERE ARE KNEE DROPS IN THE ROUTINE.

- Rosin is permitted but is to be provided by the individual or teacher. NO Rosin is to be spread on the floor Side stage or Dressing room area. You must keep the rosin within a container and clean up any spills created.
- Competitors dance completely at their own risk and are therefore responsible for
 insuring themselves against personal injury arising out of participation in the competition.
 In the event of an accident or illness, an ambulance may be called. Any associated cost
 incurred will be charged to the parent or guardian. Ambulance subscription is
 recommended
- Cameras or recording equipment will not be permitted in the auditorium with the
 exception of the video and photo personnel hired by STARSTRUCK.
 Any offender will be requested to leave the competition after being asked to delete
 any recording of the competition from their device.

Props and Music

Due to Copyright and any State or Federal laws – all dancers/ vocalists must have the
permission of the choreographing teacher to perform dance/s or songs & have permission
to use all music. In accordance with federal statutes, competitors must use <u>original</u>
material or have permission from the relevant owners of copyright. All competitors are
responsible for gaining permission/ licenses required to use any music.

Music with shoe tapping beats in any Tap section is prohibited.

Music with vocals (including backing) is prohibited in ALL

Song & Dance/Tap and Vocal sections.

PLEASE NOTE: NO MUSIC WILL BE ACCEPTED ON THE DAY. ALL MUSIC NEEDS TO BE SUBMITTED THROUGH MUSIC UPLOADS BY THE DUE DATE.

LATE MUSIC SUBMISSIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED BUT A \$10 LATE FEE WILL APPLY.

Props are permitted, but you must have someone organised to move your props on and
off the stage. Props must be removed from the backstage area immediately after your
section is finished. If a prop is thrown into the wings, you must have someone present
sidestage to catch it.

GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP IS A REQUIREMENT OF ENTRY TO THIS COMPETITION.
ANY COMPETITORS WHO ENGAGE IN UNSPORTSMAN LIKE BEHAVIOUR WILL BE ASKED
TO LEAVE THE COMPETITION IMMEDIATELY. NO WARNINGS OR REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN.

BY ENTERING OUR COMPETITION YOU AGREE TO ALL THE RULES THAT HAVE BEEN SET OUT IN THIS DOCUMENT.

Section Explanations

- Tap Solo: Any style or tempo of tap permitted. Lyrics are permitted. No Tap beats permitted.
- Musical Theatre / Broadway Jazz: A routine using jazz technique, that is performed to a song that has been used in a musical or Broadway theatre show/movie. Routine should contain no more than 3 individual acrobatic tricks.
- Commercial Jazz: A routine using jazz technique, that is performed to a pop song. Routine should contain no more than 3 individual acrobatic tricks.
- Neo Classical: Shows the musicality of the music, must include Classical steps and Ballet technique.
- Classical Ballet: Competitor must wear a tutu, pancake or romantic permitted. Ballet shoes or
 Pointe shoes to be worn depending on the competitor's technique level and age.
- Demi-Character: A performance where the competitor uses classical steps and technique to depict a character.
- Lyrical: A routine where the movements used depict the lyrics of the song. Competitor should have a strong emotional connection to the song. Routines typically have less classical steps in them and lean more towards a contemporary/acrobatic technique.
- Contemporary: Must use contemporary technique involving contractions, release and off-balance movements. Unpredictable changes in rhythm, speed, and direction typically shown.
- Song & Dance/ Tap: Routine that must contain 50% Singing & 50% Dance/Tap steps.
- Acrobatic: A routine which must contain acrobatic/gymnastic skills such as walkovers, backflips, balances etc. Definite choreography should be used to blend the acrobatic tricks into the routine. Routine should contain at least 50% acrobatic skills.
- All Abilities Section: For entrants who are not competitive in a general section due to disability or learning difficulties. All entrants will receive a trophy.
- Vocal Musical Theatre: A performance where the competitor sings a song from a musical theatre based stage show, broadway show or movie.
- Vocal Up-tempo: A performance where the competitor sings a song that is 140bpm or above.
- Vocal Ballad: A performance where the competitor sings a song that is below 140bpm.
