All performances will be filmed and photographed, and these will be available to order. No other filming or photography will be permitted in the auditorium.

All entrants must be within the age group specified on January 1, 2024

All entrants must hold student status i.e. Not at any time having been paid to perform as a dancer for a period of more than 12 weeks in any one year.

The decision of the judging panel is final, and no correspondence will be entered in to. The organisers of this event are not part of the judging panel.

At the judges discretion, a prize may be withheld if a level has not been achieved. Prize money may be altered by percentage if capacity not reached in age division.

FEMALE DANCERS - CLASSICAL

Masterclass and Rehearsals - Leotard for classes (any colour), pink ballet tights, Ballet flats, demi points, pointe shoes. No skirts

Performance - Costume appropriate to classical variation selection

Défilé (Finals Only) - Black thin straps leotard, black wrap skirt, pink ballet tights, ballet flats or pointe shoes.

MALE DANCERS - CLASSICAL

Masterclass and Rehearsals - Any colour tights & either firm fitted shirt or singlet type shirt, any colour ballet flats for classes is appropriate.

Performance - Costume appropriate for Variation selected

Défilé (Finals Only) - black tights, blact ballet flats, white singlet or ballet tshirt

FEMALE DANCERS - CONTEMPORARY

Masterclass and Rehearsals - black thin strap leotard, black footless tights

MALE DANCERS - CONTEMPORARY

Masterclass and Rehearsals - black singlet top, black bike shorts



DRESS CODE

DÉFILÉ (FINALS ONLY)

All dancers are required to attend all defile masterclass, rehearsals and performance. Not attending will result in not being eligible for any award prizes.

Girls - black thin straps leotard, black wrap skirt, pink ballet tights, ballet flats or pointe shoes.

Boys - black tights, blact ballet flats, white singlet or ballet tshirt

CONTEMPORARY FINALISTS

Should your dancer be selected as a contemporary finalist for their age division, they will not be required to compete a contemporary solo. Instead, each age division will learn and perform a piece appropriate to the dancer. The piece will be scored during the performance.

Any attire can be worn during classes and performance. All Finalist must be adhere to performance attire.

Girls - black thin strap leotard, black footless tights

Boys - black singlet top, black bike shorts

Dancers may or may not wear barefeet, half turning shoes, foot undies or contemporary socks



CONTEMPORARY DANCE

These sections are judged separately from the Classical Sections. It is not necessary to enter the Classical section in order to enter in the Contemporary section. Four age groups as detailed above- Sub Junior, Junior, Intermediate and Senior All entrants perform a contemporary solo with a maximum time limit of 2 minutes with own choice of choreography, music and appropriate costume. All entrants must also attend the Preliminary Contemporary master class in their age group.
