PERFORMANCE LEVELS:

Pre-Open -

Dancers have previous limited competition experience, and have not yet won 1st in this category at any competition.

Open -

Dancers who have previous competition experience, and have been placed 1st in this category at any competition.

GENRES:

Classical Ballet - Routine consisting of classical ballet movement and technique. Pointe shoes are allowed for ages 13/U - 15/O only.

Demi - Routine consisting involving, or resembling a character dance that uses classical technique as a basis for interpretation.

Repertoire - A routine based on the skills of a remembered performance done by a particular person.

Open - Either a contemporary or lyrical routine, or a second routine of the genres mentioned above.

Costume Award –

An add-on to solo(s) entered only. You do not need to perform for this entry, just simply nominate which routine you want to enter for this category. You can nominate as many solos as you like. This category will be judged at the time of the performance.

Photogenic Award -

Competitors must email through a photo no later than Friday 15th July for judging by Everline Imagery. Photos do not have to be professional, but dance related and should be of good quality and clarity, and not photographed by Everline Imagery. Photos not received by Friday 15th July will not be included. No refunds will be provided. Should there be less than 5, it may be cancelled, and your entry fee will be refunded in this instance.

TIME LIMIT - 2.5 MIN

REGISTRATION -

Entries are accepted on a first come basis and are open to amateur dancers only.

Full payment is the only method to guarantee your registration.

JUDGING GUIDELINES AND SCORING CRITERIA:

Every performance will be critiqued according to the competition level, age, and category by 1 industry adjudicator.

The score is out of 100 and based on:

- · TECHNICAL ABILITY (35%)
- · PERFORMANCE & INTERPRETATION (30%)
- · CHOREOGRAPHY & MUSICALITY (20%)
- · OVERALL APPEARANCE (15%)

The decision of the judges are final, and each judge will give a verbal critique for each entry.

Competition Day Details -

Please arrive at least 30 minutes (no more than an hour) prior to your estimated scheduled section. It is the competitor's responsibility to check in with the Backstage Manager two (2) sections prior to his/her scheduled performance. Only competitors in the (2) section will be allowed side stage at any time.

Competitors must perform in sequence of the program. The only exception to this rule is when there are less than five (5) acts in between performances and is at the Backstage Manager's discretion as to when you are positioned in the program to perform out of sequence. No dancing out of section will be permitted. Props must be mobile, and under your watch at all times. It must be brought on and off stage promptly. With the exception fo 6/U competitors, parents are not allowed backstage. Coaching and prompting from wings are only allowed for 6/U.

All dancers and competitors assume full responsibility for personal property and injuries incurred during the competition at the venue and its vicinity. This extends to all family, friends and associates of the competitors. Children under 16 should be under adult supervision at all times, or may be asked to leave the premise.

It is agreed that the competitor will not hold VIBE DANCE, or its directors, employees and volunteers liable for injuries sustained or illness contracted by them while in attendance and/or performing in any activity at VIBE DANCE.

Choreography and costuming should be kept age appropriate and suitable for family entertainment.

You are responsible to bring your own first aid kit as venues may not have them readily available. VIBE Dance is not responsible to provide any first aid treatment or equipment.

Resin is not allowed. Tap is prohibited and will be disqualified.

The adjudicators' decision is final. There is to be no communication with the adjudicator during the competition. In the event that the adjudicator(s) is unable to perform their duty, VIBE DANCE reserves the right to appoint a new adjudicator(s) without notice. All awards and prizes received are the responsibility of the individual. They can only be collected at the end of the competition. It you are unable to collect them, it is your responsibility to nominate someone to collect your award on your behalf. VIBE Dance is not responsible for posting them to you.

In order to protect the safety and privacy of all competitors and the artistic right of the choreographer, video and photography during performance is strictly prohibited.
