COMPETITION RULES

Competitors must be pupils of Registered Teachers with An Coimisiun Le Rinci Gaelacha who are also registered with AIDA SA Inc and AIDA Inc for the year 2021. Competitors must be registered with AIDA SA Inc for 2021 and proof of age must also have been ascertained.

Entries must be submitted via www.compsonline.com.au by the due date. Each family entry received after the closing date will incur a late fee of \$15.

Competitors enter at their own risk regarding injury. The Miller School will not accept any liability for injuries sustained. Lodgement of an entry will be deemed to be an acceptance of this provision by a dancer.

There must be a minimum of two (2) competitors on receipt of entries to make up an event; entries may be combined to make sections. Entry fees will be refunded if insufficient numbers are received.

All competitors must be ready to commence their section at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start time. The Feis organizing committee has the right to commence sections up to 30 minutes prior to the advertised start time.

It is the competitor's responsibility to be in the marshalling area when called, otherwise they may miss their section.

The Miller Feis reserves the right to amend the order of dances and/or dancers at any time.

Competitors will be required to dance to music supplied by the Miller School. Teachers may be required to supply their own music for set dances. There may be live music played for the Bun and Tus and Ceili sections.

If there is a problem with music, either manual or recorded, the dancer will be permitted to re-dance.

If a dancer loses a heel or a complete shoe, he/she may stand back allowing the other dancer to continue dancing uninhibited. The dancer will then be allowed to re-dance. Should a dancer bump, slip or fall, they may re-dance at the adjudicator's discretion.

If a dancer falls the adjudicator must ring the bell. The dancer will be permitted to re-dance at the adjudicator's discretion and if no injury has been sustained.

In a Premiership, where a dancer fails to complete his/her performance in any given round, that dancer is to be given zero marks by each adjudicator for that round.

The decision of the adjudicator is final.

To receive prizes or awards, competitors must be in full dancing costume including shoes.

Lead Round / heavy dancing. In all competitions for Primary level upwards, all heavy dancing ie Jig and Hornpipe, the Lead Round must be danced on both right and left foot.

In graded sections, competitors are required to perform correct standard of work as set out in the AIDA Inc Competitions Rules and Regulations. Competitors will be disqualified by adjudicators if incorrect standard of work is performed.

No block, en point, stationary or moving is allowed to be performed for all ages up to and including the 11 years and under age groups (this includes treble reels).

Costume dress necklines must be of collar-bone level or above. This does not preclude the use of alternative fabrics eg lace as an insert; where chiffon or lace material is used as sleeves, the sleeves must start at the shoulder line and end at the cuff. Appropriate underwear must be worn. Where tights are worn they must be of a denier not less than 70. Please see MakeUP /Leg Tan chart supplied. The use of artificial arm aids are not permitted.

In accordance with our obligations under the Protection policy, dancers are reminded to wear appropriate dress at all times whilst at the Feis (especially in the auditorium area). No changing in the main auditorium.

Photography and/or video is permitted in Novice sections and Beginner sections only, as per the photography statement below. Please note that any form of unauthorised photography which has the capability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion, using electronic or manual means eg mobile phone, standard camera, video camcorder, cinerecorder, commercial film with or without flash enhancement is expressly forbidden in all other levels of competition, i.e. Primary, Intermediate, Elementary and Open competition unless prior permission has been given by the Feis organizers.

The Miller School will not enter into any correspondence with parents or otherwise concerning the organization and procedure at the Feis unless these matters are put in writing and presented to your teacher to relay.

Lodgement of an entry shall be taken to signify that the Teacher, Parent and Pupils concerned accept these rules in full and agree to strictly abide by them.

This feis will be run in accordance with COVID obligations (at that time) and attendance limits and any other important, updated information will be issued prior to the date of the feis (if necessary).
