- Troupe Age is NOT AVERAGE AGE
- NO REFUNDS, transfers may be offered.
- Poaching or intimidation of students will not be tolerated.
- The Convenors reserve the right to combine entries, alter the program, venue, date or adjudicator where deemed necessary.
- All dancers / competitors compete at their own risk. Tutus and tapshoes eisteddfod takes NO responsibility for any accidents, injury or death to any persons associated with this Eisteddfod, either as a competitor, volunteer, or a member of the public at any time.
- MUSIC-all music needs to be uploaded via music uploads online.
- The adjudicators decision is FINAL, any parents, competitors or teachers approaching the adjudicator will be disqualified and asked to leave the venue.
- All competitors perform at their own risk. No responsibility
 accepted for any injury, accident or loss of property which occurs
 during the comp. This applies to all persons present at the comp.
- Any person exhibiting obnoxious, disrespectful o run-sportsman-like behaviour will be asked to leave and/or disqualified from further competition viewing & will render their studio ineligible for further competition .THISI NCLUDES NEGATIVE COMMENTS RE ADJUDICATOR OR HIS/HER DECISIONS (includes after event correspondence and social media). Teachers & parents are expected to advise students & spectators of this rule & encourage positive competition decorum.
- All competitors give their permission for photos to be used by Tutus and tap shoes eisteddfod for promotional material, this includes results on social media.

- NO practising in the hall.
- Tap shoes to be covered.
- This event is an alcohol free zone.
- All Programs will be uploaded to social media or emailed.
- No resin is to be used.
- Music to be uploaded to Music uploads
- Copy of child's birth certificate required on first entry.
- Entry not confirmed until payment has been made.
- Prompting will not be permitted except for babies sections.
- There is to be quiet in the hall at all times.
- No dancer is to perform out of section
- Unfinished dances may be repeated at the discretion of the adjudicator except 12yrs and over.
- Time limits: Babies 2.5 mins, Solos 3 mins
- Music uploads and voice critiques.

Solo section definitions

- <u>First year learning</u>-The competitor must have only recently begun the genre within the 12 month period preceding the commencement of the competition year for that discipline.
- <u>Specially Restricted</u>- For competitors who have never won that style of dance in any competitions.
- <u>Restricted-</u> For competitors who have not won restricted in that style, but have won in the specially restricted for that style (Babies sections are not included)
- <u>Open-</u> For competitors who have won specially restricted and restricted in that style.
