All entries to be lodged on-line by the closing date. Event may close early if capacity is reached prior to date.

Each dancer will perform 3 routines, a Jazz, Contemporary and a Lyrical routine. Each Routine will be scored out of 100.

There will be 2 adjudicators.

Total score for 3 routines, 2 adjudicators, will be out off 600.

Each routine will be scored and then added together for a total score. There will be two judges, each judge will mark every routine out of 100. Judges scores will be added together for grand total score out of 600 for the 3 routines.

TOP FIVE in each age group go through to PLATINUM DANCER OF THE YEAR FINAL.

Entrants are required to perform one routine at the finals, routine may NOT be a repeat of dance from sections. This routine will be scored and added to your combined total from age group sections.

MUSIC

Music needs to be uploaded in advance of the competition using - Music Uploads.

All music should be recorded at proper speed.

FOR EMERGENCY it is advisable to have a duplicate USB.

TIME LIMITS

Solos 3:00 min

NUMBER OF ENTRIES

Entries will be on a first come, first serve basis and will be limited to the amount of performance time available. PLATINUM DANCE COMPETITION reserves the right to add additional competition days or move the competition location due to unforeseen circumstances.

PLATINUM DANCE COMPETITION also bears the right to refuse entries at their discretion.

Any change in competition days and/or times is at the sole discretion of PLATINUM

DANCE COMPETITION and will be determined by the amount of time available at each regional competition.

In the event that you need to change sections a \$20.00 administration fee will be charged. Changes need to be submitted via email 7 days prior to start of event.

PLATINUM DANCE COMPETITION - STYLE

COMMERCIAL CONTEMPORARY – A routine with the intention of creating popular awareness to popular & current movements used to enhance a more present day contemporary style.

TRADITIONAL CONTEMPORARY – A routine where the movements have arisen from the tradition of this dance style. Primarily teaching the younger generations the history of this art form.

LYRICAL - A routine that is performed to the lyrics or mood of the music.

JAZZ - A routine that utilises jazz technique such as splits, isolation, leaps.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- There are no refunds, except if a section or the event is cancelled.
- The order of appearance will not be changed. Competitors must accept and follow the order. Under NO circumstances will this order change.
- Restarts. A competitor who commences performing and stops will be permitted to performing at end of section. Competitor will receive a report only and not be eligible for a placing.

 therefore it is a good idea to arrive early in case this may be the case. PLATINUM
 DANCE COMPETITION holds no responsibility if you miss your event due to event
 running ahead of schedule.
- Adjudicators decision is final. There is to be no communication with the adjudicator except for the offical staff at PLATINUM DANCE EVENT.
- If insufficient numbers in a section, the organiser reserves the right to amend, combine, or cancel sections at their discretion.

- Props must be removed from stage as soon as possible after performance is completed and removed completely from side stage.
- All participants give their permission for any photograph or video taken of them by PLATINUM DANCE COMPETITION to be used in promotion. This includes ads, website, social media, newsletters, brochures and any other form of marketing both print and digital on behalf of PLATINUM DANCE COMPETITION. Videos, cameras and mobile phone photography is STRICTLY NOT PERMITTED and may lead to a competitor being disqualified. Teachers, please advise parents of this restriction. An official photographer and videographer will be available to record your dances for a fee.
- All rubbish and items must be removed from the venue and change rooms when you leave. Please leave change rooms and hall in the clean and tidy condition in which they were found.
- No smoking is permitted anywhere on school grounds.
- PLATINUM DANCE COMPETITION expects all studios that participate in events to maintain a high moral standard, keep a positive attitude, and encouraging nature.
- We promote an environment of positive energy and growth of the students.
