Rules & Conditions

Entry Forms

No Prize will be awarded unless there is sufficient merit. The Adjudicator shall

have the power to withhold any prize at his/her discretion.

- 1. All Entries must be lodged through Comps-Online

- 3. The Committee will not be held responsible for any errors or omissions on entry forms
- 4. Strictly one entry per competitor per section.
- 5. Competitors may enter a duo/trio event with different partners
- 6. The maximum number of times an individual can enter in the same duo/trio section is 2.
- 7. Entries in all categories, with the exception of Open sections, must contain the correct Date of Birth of the entrant. Entries without the

correct date of birth will not be accepted.

Age

8. Each competitor must pay the \$15 competitor pass fee with their entry fees. This includes each duo and trio partner.

Groups day/s and all other spectators have a seperate entry fee.

9. Strictly no refunds policy

- 1. The age of the entrant must be as at the 1st January 2024
- 2. Performers in open section may be of any age, although must be of open standard

Material

3. For duo/trio and group sections the age classification will be determined

but the age of the oldest member of each duo/trio or group as at the 1st January 2024

Time Limits

- 1. All material must be age appropriate
- 2. Music MUST be submitted via music uploads
- 3. In all cases a backup copy of the music, on iPod, iPhone, Laptop or device, should be available.
- 4. All music is to be pre-cut, mixed or faded.
- 5. In dance sections, vocal backing is not permitted in the vocal section of any Song &Dance item. Some newer backing tapes may have fragments of added harmonisation, which is acceptable.
- 1. Solo sections have a time limit of 3minutes unless otherwise

Withdrawals

specified

2. All other sections have a time limit of 5minutes unless otherwise

specified

3. Song and Dance and Song and Tap sections have a limit of 5minutes

- 4. Adjudicators have the right to stop a performance if the time limit is exceeded
- 1. Entries will not be refunded if an entrant withdraws
- 2. Entries can only be withdrawn by the teacher or parent of the entrant. Withdrawals from other parties will not be accepted

Performance

3. Entrants must advise the Secretary or backstage official if withdrawing from a section at the earliest convenience or at the start of

the relevant session.

- 4. Entrants will be withdrawn by the Secretary or backstage official if not present in the marshalling area 10minutes prior to their performance.
- 1. All entrants must mark themselves present with the backstage official at the beginning of the relevant session
- 2. All entrants must be side stage at least 10minutes prior to their section or risk being withdrawn by the backstage official
- 3. Appropriate attire must be worn by all entrants relevant to their section. This includes the wearing of dance tights and shoes relevant to the genre of dance.

Adjudication

- 4. Inappropriate behaviour side stage and onstage whilst performing will not be tolerated.
- 5. Any prompting is strictly not permitted in any sections. Any persons within the audience or side stage caught prompting will be removed from the auditorium or backstage area.

- 1. The adjudicator holds the power to disqualify or penalise an entrant for inappropriate or offensive attire, behaviour, prompting and material choice.
- 2. The adjudicator may withhold prizes according to merit.,

Powers of the Committee

3. The adjudicators decision is

final unless an error in identity occurs

- 4. In any improvisation sections all material is the choice of the adjudicator.
- 5. Adjudicator reports will be via music uploads and will be made available at the end of each day.
- The Committee reserves the right to amend or refuse any entry, combine or cancel any section for which insufficient entries have been received
- 2. The Committee reserves the right to split any sections should the entries be considered to many for a section
- 3. Failure to comply with any of the Rules and Conditions may involve disqualification and withholding of prizes
- 4. The decision of the Committee in all questions and disputes arising out of, or not provided for, in the Rules and Conditions shall be final. All entries are received subject to this rule and shall not be subject to any appeal at law.

Protests

- 5. No responsibility will be accepted for errors and omissions in the
- Syllabus or Programme. Competitors should check programme against their entry form at the time of receiving the programme
- 6. The Committee reserves the right to change the date/venue of the event if considered necessary
- 7. The Committee has full control of the programme at all times

Auditorium Rules

- Protests / Appeals / Complaints
 must be lodged in writing with the Committee within 30minutes of
 the completion of the relevant section with a fee of \$25
- Such appeals may include, but are not limited to, alleged competitor number mistakes, error in calculation of marks, competitor ineligibility, interpretation of rules, etc.
- 1. Flash cameras are not to be used during performance. Please see Photography and Videography section for further rules
- 2. Mobile phones, pagers and any devices are to be turned off or set to silent/vibrate whilst the session is underway
- 3. Members of the audience may not enter or exit the auditorium whilst a performance is occurring
- 4. Members of the audience must not make excessive noise by way of talking, skylarking, shouting or calling out whilst a performance is occurring
- 5. Members of the audience may not speak with a competitor whilst they are performing. Interfering with their performance may result

in being asked to leave the auditorium

- or the penalisation or disqualification of the competitor
- 6. Young children must be kept under control at all times or risk being asked to leave the auditorium

- 2. Any persons caught taking photos or videos of performers not at

the designated table will be asked to delete photos and/or videos taken on their device and immediately escorted from the building

- 3. The committee may have an official photographer to take images of the eisteddfod for advertising and social media purposes
- Members of the media may take photos for advertising and media purposes
- 5. Members of the Committee may take photos to publish on social media and websites. Should you not wish for your photograph to be taken by the Committee please speak with the Secretary.

- 1. Entrants in improvisations must marshal side stage at least one section prior to the improvisation. Entrants will be disqualified if not present when called for or if the section has already started before they marshal.
- 2. Entrants in improvisations must wear plain class leotard, no bling, sequins, etc. plain coloured shorts or skirts are permitted as competitors 'choice. Any competitor presenting for improvisation in inappropriate outfit will have one chance to change while in the toilets awaiting their turn in the improvisation, but must be able to change themselves
- 3. Entrants in solo improvisation may choose the genre of dance they will present upon hearing the music selected by the adjudicator.
- 4. Group improvisation entrants must have a minimum of 4 competitors for each group. Only group members can be present in the time allocated during in which the group must choreograph their own unique steps. Genre chosen will be at the groups discretion upon receiving music selected by our adjudicator. Music will be received at the end of one session and improvisation performances will begin starting the next session. Space will be allocated for each group to choreograph. Junior group improvisation entries must have one teacher or student teacher present at music receival and will be allocated another group to time keep for. This student teacher or teacher is for counting purposes only. Music will be airdropped or emailed and it is up to the group to provide a means of playing during the choreography

- time. Group Improvisations will be conducted during groups day/s. Groups do not have to be school based, and students may enter with whomever they please.
- 5. No parents, teachers, friends or anyone else, other than committee members or improvisation marshals, may approach or interact with improvisation competitors once music starts until improvisation section is completed. Failure to comply will result in the disqualification of competitor.
- 6. Adjudicators combo will be in either Jazz, Lyrical / Slow Modern or Contemporary. Once the entrant has lodged their fees they will receive the combo on the release of the programme. Should the section not run, entry fee into the section will be refunded. Attire is as per rule 5, improvisation attire.
- 7. Choreographers Challenge entrants must compete in the adjudicators combo, student choreography and the improvisation section. The entrants must also choreograph one routine to be entered for another solo/duo/trio or group. The entrant cannot be in this choreographed piece. The choreographed piece may have costuming. The choreographed piece may be a repeated piece from another section.
- 8. No routine in any section other than Acro may have more than 4 tricks. Tricks are classified as any move where the hips go over the head walkovers, round offs, aerials, baranis, handsprings, chin stand, etc. are classed as a trick. Each ONE of these elements is counted as a trick, failure to comply with the 4-trick limit will result in disqualification from placing in that routine. Moves NOT classed as an acro trick are cartwheels, shoulder rolls, leg mounts and well

- executed knee drops. A routine entered in the acro section must still be dance based. Any questions regarding permissible tricks not listed may be directed to the committee, either via facebook or email.
- No person is permitted on stage at any time other than for prop placement.
- 10. No person (including teachers, parents or any non-competitor)

 other than the

backstage official/announcer, music player or

Committee members will be allowed side stage during performances.

- 11. Student choreography events must be FULLY student's own work.

 Entrants must choose own music and style of dance. Costume must suit dance.
- 12. Taps must not be worn in any part of the auditorium except on the stage.
- 13. Competitors must use the dressing areas provided and not change in the auditorium or passageways.
- 14. All entrants must dance in order of the program to avoid confusion
