

# LEVEL UP SOLO Challenge




**One day only – all age groups**

An exciting opportunity for dancers of every level to shine on stage!

## Key Details

- **Date:** October 8<sup>th</sup> 2025
- **Adjudicator:** To be confirmed closer to the event. Always a *current industry professional*—we pride ourselves on bringing in someone fresh each time.
- **Age Rule:** Age as of **January 1st, 2025**
- **Age Categories:**
  - 6/u
  - 8/u
  - 10/u
  - 12/u
  - 14/u
  - OPEN
- **Sections:**
  - *Rising Star* (Novice/Beginner) a new competitor
  - *Elite* (Advanced) If your dancer has won previously
- **Entries via:** Comps Online
- **Entries close:** Once we reach maximum capacity, or **1 month prior**
- **Minimum:** 5 entrants required per section
- **Music:**
  - Max **3 minutes** (marks may be deducted if over time)
  - **Digital submission only** – Dropbox link will be provided once entries are received
  - No music accepted on the day (backups recommended).
  - If music is not submitted, we will assume you are not attending

## General Information

-  **No spectator fees** – all costs are covered in competitor entry fees
-  Dressing room available
-  All 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places receive a **trophy** (no ribbons awarded)

## Important Rules:

- No refunds unless a section/event is cancelled
- Competitors & spectators enter at their own risk; no responsibility for accidents, injury, or loss of property (including motor vehicles)
- A qualified adjudicator will judge all entries; decisions are final. Approaching judges is strictly prohibited.

- Props/sets must be placed and removed quickly
- Competitors must confirm attendance at the **music desk** before their section starts
- Any section with over 20 competitors may be split (Part A & B). Insufficient numbers may lead to sections being combined at organiser's discretion
- **Tap shoes** not permitted inside the venue (strictly enforced)
- No photography, filming, or mobile phone use inside the theatre—breach may lead to disqualification
- No smoking anywhere on school grounds
- Entrants must arrive **1 hour prior** – competition may run up to 1 hour early. LEVEL UP holds no responsibility for missed routines if event is ahead of schedule
- Once the schedule is finalised, **no rescheduling requests** will be accepted. Dancers/studios must be flexible with performance times
- By entering, participants agree not to hold LEVEL UP SOLO CHALLENGE, its staff, directors, or host facilities responsible for injury or property loss
- Participation grants permission for LEVEL UP SOLO CHALLENGE to use event photos/videos in promotions (ads, website, social media, brochures, newsletters, etc.)
- Family-friendly environment: routines must be appropriate for all ages. Explicit lyrics, suggestive or overly mature material may result in point deductions. Good sportsmanship is expected from all dancers, parents, and teachers.
