SOLO GRADING

WHEN ENTRIES PERMIT WE WILL DIVIDE COMPETITORS BY SPECIALLY RESTRICTED, RESTRICTED AND OPEN.

SPECIALLY RESTRICTED: PERFORMERS WHO HAVE NEVER PLACED FIRST IN ANY EISTEDDFOD OR COMPETITION, IN A SPECIALLY RESTRICTED OR ABOVE SECTION IN THAT GENRE.

RESTRICTED: PERFORMERS WHO HAVE NEVER PLACED FIRST IN ANY EISTEDDFOD OR COMPETITION, IN A RESTRICTED OR ABOVE SECTION IN THAT GENRE.

OPEN: OPEN TO ANY PERFORMER.



AWARDS & CHAMPIONSHIPS

AWARDS

AWARDS WILL BE ANNOUNCED AT THE END OF EACH SECTION. ALL PERFORMERS OR A TEACHER/PARENT/CARER MUST BE PRESENT TO COLLECT THE AWARDS FROM THE AWARDS TABLE. IF AWARDS ARE NOT COLLECTED THEY ARE FORFEITED.

DISTRIBUTION OF PLACES IS AT ADJUDICATORS DISCRETION. THE ADJUDICATOR WILL ALSO PROVIDE A SCORE AND REPORT.

AWARDS WILL BE A COMBINATION OF TROPHIES, MEDALS, CROWNS, RIBBONS AND SASHES.

CHAMPIONSHIPS

OUR ADJUDICATOR WILL SELECT UP TO 10 PERFORMERS TO COMPETE FOR AGE CHAMPIONSHIPS FROM EACH AGE GROUP. SELECTED AGE CHAMPIONSHIP FINALISTS MUST PERFORM THE PERFORMANCE SELECTED BY THE ADJUDICATOR AGAIN AT THE END OF THE AGE GROUP. THE ADJUDICATOR WILL ANNOUNCE ANY QUALIFYING PERFORMANCES DURING EACH SECTION AWARDS. EACH AGE GROUP WILL BE PRESENTED CHAMPIONSHIP FINALISTS, RISING STAR, RUNNER-UP AND CHAMPION. THERE IS NO ADDITIONAL FEE IF SELECTED FOR CHAMPIONSHIPS.

ADJUDICATOR

WE ARE PROUD TO HAVE SOME OF THE BEST ADJUDICATORS IN THE INDUSTRY. ALL ADJUDICATORS WILL BE ANNOUNCED IN OUR DRAFT PROGRAM. IF AN ADJUDICATOR IS UNABLE TO PERFORM THEIR DUTIES, WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO APPOINT A NEW ADJUDICATOR. THE ADJUDICATOR'S DECISION IS FINAL. WE DO NOT OFFER A CHALLENGE SYSTEM. IF A CONFLICT OF INTEREST OCCURS, THE ORGANISER WILL PROVIDE A RESOLUTION.

PROPS AND ACCESSORIES

PROPS CAN BE USED IF NECESSARY FOR THE PERFORMANCE. IT IS THE ENTRANTS RESPONSIBILITY TO PLACE THE PROP ON STAGE. ANY PROPS MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE STAGE IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE PERFORMANCE.

PLEASE NO THROWN GLITTER OR POWDER, NO WEAPONS, NO WATER OR ANY OTHER ITEM THAT COULD CAUSE A SAFETY HAZARD.

TAP COVERS MUST BE WORN WHEN NOT ON STAGE. ALL SINGERS MUST PROVIDE THEIR OWN MICROPHONE COVER.

POINTE SHOES CAN ONLY BE WORN BY PERFORMERS APPROVED BY THEIR TEACHER



TERMS & CONDITIONS



1. **ALL PERFORMERS ARE EXPECTED TO ARRIVE ONE HOUR PRIOR TO PERFORMANCE TIME. SECTIONS MAY COMMENCE UP TO 30 MINUTES EARLY.**
2. **ALL PERFORMERS ARE EXPECTED TO PERFORM AT THE PROGRAMMED TIME AND DAY. QUICK CHANGES WILL BE GIVEN ADEQUATE TIME TO PREPARE.**
3. **RESTRICTED AND OPEN COMPETITORS CANNOT RETURN TO THE STAGE IF A ROUTINE IS FORGOTTEN. SPECIALLY RESTRICTED WILL BE GIVEN AN ADDITIONAL ATTEMPT.**
4. **ALL PERFORMERS ARE EXPECTED TO BE PRESENT FOR AWARDS.**
5. **ALL CHAMPIONSHIP FINALISTS WILL ONLY BE AWARDED IF PRESENT TO PERFORM AGAIN.**
6. **PLEASE BE KIND AND COURTEOUS WITH OUR TEAM. MANY ARE VOLUNTEERS AND ARE AVAILABLE TO MAKE YOUR DAY AS ENJOYABLE AS POSSIBLE.**
7. **BACKSTAGE IS ONLY TO BE ACCESSED BY THE THEATRE ARTS TITLES TEAM, TEACHERS AND PERFORMERS WHEN NECESSARY TO PERFORM.**
8. **SIDE STAGE CAN ONLY BE ACCESSED BY PERFORMERS AND THE THEATRE ARTS TITLES TEAM.**
9. **BULLYING OR INTIMIDATION AT OUR COMPETITION IS NOT ACCEPTABLE.**
10. **CHOREOGRAPHERS MUST BE AWARE THAT THEIR CHOREOGRAPHY IS BEING PERFORMED. PERMISSION MUST BE PROVIDED.**
11. **CHILDREN MUST BE SUPERVISED BY AN ADULT AT ALL TIMES.**
12. **PLEASE BE RESPECTFUL OF THE VENUE AND SHARED SPACES. PLACE RUBBISH IN BINS PROVIDED.**
13. **THE AUDIENCE AND FELLOW PARTICIPANTS SHOULD CELEBRATE ALL PERFORMERS RESPECTFULLY. NOISE MUST BE KEPT TO A MINIMUM WHEN A PERFORMER IS ON STAGE.**
14. **ALL MUSIC PROVIDED TO THEATRE ARTS TITLES MUST BE PROPERLY LICENSED FOR LIVE PERFORMANCE USE. MUSIC SHOULD BE AGE APPROPRIATE AND FREE FROM ANY EXPLICIT LANGUAGE.**
15. **ALL ATTENDEES, BE THEM COMPETITORS, SPECTATORS, TEACHERS, PATRONS OR VOLUNTEERS INDEMNIFY THEATRE ARTS TITLES AND ITS OPERATORS ON BOTH A COMMERCIAL AND PERSONAL BASIS AGAINST ALL ACTIONS, SUITS, PROCEEDINGS, CLAIMS, DEMANDS, COSTS AND EXPENSES WHATSOEVER WHICH MAY BE MADE AGAINST THEATRE ARTS TITLES. NOT LIMITED TO LOSS OF PROPERTY OR PERSONAL INJURY TO THOSE IN ATTENDANCE. FULL CARE, BUT NO RESPONSIBILITY WILL BE TAKEN FOR INJURIES OR LOST PROPERTY. ENTRY IS BY YOUR OWN RISK.**
